

**SUBJECT:** Appointment of Councilman Art Hall to Alamo Workforce  
Development Board Committee of Six (alternate)

**DATE:** August 29, 2003

The Alamo Workforce Development Board (AWDB) Committee of Six is composed of two representatives from each of the principal entities, which are the City of San Antonio, Bexar County, and the Area Judges. The Committee of Six represents the entities on issues relating to the Partnership Agreement between the Principals and AWDB. The Partnership Agreement establishes the authority, roles, and responsibilities of the Principals and AWDB with regard to workforce development and related issues. Among those responsibilities are the appointment and removal of board members; approval of the operating plan, the budget, and major service provider contracts; and selection of the executive director.

Councilman Barrera and I serve as the two elected city officials on the AWDB Committee of Six. The Partnership Agreement allows for appointment of an alternate to ensure representation on the committee. Bexar County Commissioners Court and the Area Rural Judges each have an appointed alternate. I ask that you place on the September 11, 2003, City Council Agenda an item appointing Councilman Art Hall as an alternate representative for the City of San Antonio.
