SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This ordinance appropriates funds in the amount of \$4,000 payable to Texas Natural Resource Conservation Commission (TNRCC) from 2002 Certificates of Obligation funds in connection with the Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) Thousand Oaks Intersections Improvements project, an authorized 1999 General Obligation Street Improvement Bond project, located in Council Districts 9 and 10.

Staff recommends approval of this ordinance.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

This project provides for the reconstruction of a four-lane intersection on Thousand Oaks between US 281 and Jones-Maltsberger to provide left and/or right turn lanes for total of 5 to 6 lanes at Broken Oak, Ledge View, Turkey Point, Pebble Forest and Oak Leigh. This project is currently near design completion. This project is scheduled to advertise for bids January 2004, begin construction March 2004, and be completed by January 2005.

Because of the construction of this project over the Edward's Aquifer Recharge Zone, the Texas Natural Resources Conservation Commission (TNRCC) requires the submittal of a Water Pollution Abatement Plan with a corresponding application and review fee of \$4,000 for non-residential projects between 5 and 10 acres.

While this project was originally identified as a 1999 General Obligation Street Improvement Bond project, costs associated with the purchase of right of way and inflation has increased significantly. Therefore, it is necessary to use resources from Certificates of Obligation to support the added costs.

POLICY ANALYSIS

Approval of this ordinance will be a continuation of City Council policy to complete previously approved Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) 1999 General Obligation Street Improvement Bond funded Capital Improvements Projects.

FISCAL IMPACT

This is a one-time capital improvement expenditure within budget and included in the FY03-08 Capital Improvement Program Budget. Funds in the amount of \$4,000 are available from 2002 Certificates of Obligation funds and authorized payable to TNRCC.

COORDINATION

This request for ordinance has been coordinated with the Office of Management and Budget and the Finance Department.

SUPPLEMENTARY COMMENTS


