SUMMARY & RECOMMENDATION

This ordinance will amend Ordinance No. 98020 passed on August 14,2003 to reflect changes in polling sites as outlined in Attachment A and entities involved in the November 4, 2003 Joint and Special Election.

Staff recommends approval of this ordinance in order to transmit the information to the U.S. Department of Justice.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Due to voters' preference, accessibility issues and availability of certain locations, changes in polling sites are necessary.

Additionally, Ordinance No. 98020 shall be amended to reflect changes in the entities involved in the November 4, 2003 election. The November 4, 2003 election will now be a joint election between the City of San Antonio, Bexar County, Northeast Independent School District (NEISD) and Bexar Metropolitan Water District (Bexar Met).

FINANCIAL IMP/ "I"

Funds for the election are provided under the Municipal Elections budget. This election is estimated to cost \$372,400.29.

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COORDINATION

The proposed ordinance has been coordinated with the City Attorney's Office, Office of Budget and Management, and Bexar County Elections Administrator.

JOINT ELECTION AGREEMENT

This Agreement is entered into by and between the City of San Antonio, a Texas Municipal Corporation ("the CITY"), acting by and through its City Manager, and Bexar County ("the COUNTY"), and the Northeast Independent School District ("the NEISD"), and the Bexar Metropolitan Water District ("BEXAR MET"), acting by and through their duly appointed and qualified representatives, pursuant to Texas Election Code Section 271.002(a), and is as follows:

WHEREAS, the City of San Antonio, Bexar County, and the Northeast Independent School District will conduct bond elections, on Tuesday, November 4,2003; and

WHEREAS, the Bexar Metropolitan Water District will conduct a trustee election, on Tuesday, November 4,2003; and

WHEREAS, Section 271.002(a) of the Texas Election Code authorizes two or more political subdivisions to enter into an agreement to hold elections jointly in the election precincts that can be served by common polling places; and

WHEREAS, the parties to this agreement desire that a joint election be held in order to provide a convenient, simple, and cost-saving election to the voters of the CITY, the COUNTY, the NEISD, and BEXAR MET; and

WHEREAS, the CITY, the COUNTY, the NEISD, and BEXAR MET desire to enter into an agreement setting out the respective duties and responsibilities of the parties for the November 4,2003 election; and

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby agreed that the CITY, the COUNTY, the NEISD, and BEXAR MET will hold a joint election under the following terms and conditions:

I

The City of San Antonio has entered into a contract with the Bexar County Elections Administrator to provide personnel and equipment for conducting its election at each of the voting places as agreed by all parties. The Bexar County Elections Administrator will provide election services to the COUNTY. The NEISD and BEXAR MET are required to enter into their own separate agreements with Bexar County for election services.

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The CITY, the COUNTY, the NEISD, and BEXAR MET agree to conduct early voting jointly. The Bexar County Elections Administrator will handle and arrange for early voting in person and by mail in the joint election for all participating political subdivisions, in accordance with their respective agreements.

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The CITY, the COUNTY, the NEISD, and the BEXAR MET agree that a single ballot, containing all the measures and offices to be voted on at a particular polling place, shall be used in this joint election.

IV

Each party to this agreement is responsible for its own printing and publication costs in connection with the Joint Election.

V

The NEISD will be responsible for paying the Bexar County Elections Administrator for any and all other election costs, as agreed upon by separate agreement between the NEISD and Bexar County. The BEXAR MET will be responsible for paying the Bexar County Elections Administrator for any and all other election costs, as agreed upon by separate agreement between BEXAR MET and Bexar County.

VI

Bexar County will provide a set of copies of the affidavit page of each return along with the returns of the election. Officials of each party to this agreement will make the tally of each party's election.

VII

Each party to this agreement is responsible for canvassing its own returns for the Joint Election.

VIII

Each party to this agreement is responsible for preparing and sending its own individual Department of Justice Preclearance Submissions.

The CITY, the COUNTY, the NEISD, and BEXAR MET	agree to	comply	with	any	and
all applicable state and federal record retention statutes.					

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The undersigned are the duly authorized representatives of the parties' governing bodies, and their signatures represent acceptance of the terms and conditions of this agreement.
