OF HEALTH FOR THE MILK AND DAIRY LABORATORY SAMPLE

TESTING PROGRAM

SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This ordinance authorizes the City Manager to accept and execute an amendment to a contract with the Texas Department of Health (TDH) that will provide up to \$34,500.00 in funding to support the ongoing Milk and Dairy Laboratory Sample Testing Program of the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District (SAMHD) for the period September 1, 2003 through August 31, 2004. In addition, this ordinance adopts the program budget and approves payments for contractual laboratory services.

Staff recommends approval.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

TDH provides annual financial assistance to SAMHD through several contracts to supplement the delivery of local public health services. Generally, these contracts are designed to renew grant programs as their terms expire at various times during the year. Each time that a certain grant comes up for renewal, TDH will offer a Contract Change Notice to amend the overall contract and provide continuation funds for that grant. TDH has now offered a Contract Change Notice to Contract #7460020708C 2004 to continue support for the ongoing Milk and Dairy Laboratory Sample Testing Program in the SAMHD for up to \$34,500.00.

The SAMHD Public Health Laboratory tests approximately 5,650 milk samples per year from processing plants located in San Antonio and the surrounding TDH Region 8 area. Samples are processed within 48 to 72 hours after collection. Among the tests performed on the samples are tests for bacteria, pasteurization, the absence of antibiotics, and an added water test to determine if water has been added to the product. Test results are faxed to TDH in Austin for monitoring.

Funding support for this program remains the same as last year. Reimbursement to SAMHD under this contract will be made based on a specific fee schedule for the laboratory procedures provided.

POLICY ANALYSIS

Acceptance of this contract amendment from TDH will continue the long-standing practice of utilizing Federal and State aid to support local public health programs of the City.

FISCAL IMPACT

This contract amendment provides \$34,500.00 in contract support to renew the ongoing Milk and Dairy Laboratory Sample Testing Program in the SAMHD for the period September 1, 2003 through August 31, 2004. Acceptance of this amendment will place no demands on the City General Fund.

In addition, this ordinance approves payments to outside laboratories for various services that may be required during the course of the year.

COORDINATION

The City Attorney's Office and the Office of Management and Budget, Risk Management Division, have reviewed and approved the contract with TDH. The Finance Department has approved the proposed budget.

SUPPLEMENTARY COMMENTS

Provisions of the Ethics Ordinance do not apply.

SECTION I. SCOPE OF WORK:

PERFORMING AGENCY shall provide analyses of milk samples. Analyses shall meet laboratory proficiency standards as set by the National Conference of Interstate Milk Shipments and the 1999 U.S. Public Health Service Grade "A" Pasteurized Milk Ordinance, 25 TAC Chapter 217. PERFORMING AGENCY shall:

- 1. Only perform the tests requested by RECEIVING AGENCY for each sample and mail results to RECEIVING AGENCY within 48 hours from the date of sample submission to PERFORMING AGENCY laboratory. RECEIVING AGENCY will provide mailers;
- 2. Send original copy of laboratory results forms to RECEIVING AGENCY, Milk and Dairy Products Division, 1100 West 49th Street, Austin, Texas 78756 to be microfilmed and returned to PERFORMING AGENCY; and,
- 3. Submit monthly vouchers, which include total number and type of tests performed to RECEIVING AGENCY, Milk and Dairy Products Division.

PERFORMING AGENCY shall comply with Chapter 435, Health and Safety Code, Dairy Products.

PERFORMING AGENCY shall provide an estimated 5,652 analyses of milk samples in the service area defined as: Statewide

SECTION II. SPECIAL PROVISIONS:
