SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATION

This ordinance authorizes the City Manager or her designated representative to accept accumulated donations in the amount of \$3,250.00 from Wal-Mart (\$1,500.00), San Antonio Professional Firefighters (\$500.00), Independent Insurance Agents of San Antonio (\$500.00) and Firemen's Benevolent Fund (\$750.00).

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

As a community relations initiative, Wal-Mart, San Antonio Professional Firefighters, Independent Insurance Agents of San Antonio and Firemen's Benevolent Fund have indicated a desire to make contributions to the City of San Antonio Fire Department. These funds will be utilized to support Fire Department Public Education Programs. The programs range from the Adopt a School Program to Fire Prevention Week activities. Donations such as these make it possible to provide much needed safety education throughout our community.

FISCAL IMPACT


The amount of the total contributions is \$3,250.00. There is no General Fund commitment.




