SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This ordinance authorizes funds in the amount of \$5,445 from Certificates of Obligation, payable to Site Specifics for expert testimony in connection with the Bitters Road from West Avenue to Heimer Metropolitan Planning Organization (MPO) project, an authorized Certificates of Obligation project located in Council District 9.

Staff recommends approval of this ordinance.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

City Ordinance No. 95362, dated February 28, 2002, authorized the filing of eminent domain action to obtain fee simple title and a temporary easement to this property in the Bitters Road from West Avenue to Heimer Metropolitan Planning Organization Project. Condemnation Cause No. 2003-ED-0009, City of San Antonio vs. Countryside Plaza, Ltd., Et Al (a large shopping center), Site Specifics provided expert testimony at the Special Commissioners Hearing held on August 22, 2003.

There are six signed instruments and one condemned parcel in the nine-parcel project. Two parcels have been submitted to the City Attorney's Office for condemnation proceedings. This project is currently under construction and scheduled to be completed in November 2004. The scope of this project includes the widening of the existing roadway to seven lanes, adding left and right turn lanes at U.S. 281 to facilitate traffic through the intersection of U.S. 281, and upgrade traffic signalization. This project will also include the construction of six-foot sidewalks at the curb.

POLICY ANALYSIS

The acquisition of this property is necessary to complete the real estate transaction of this project.

FISCAL IMPACT

This is a one-time capital improvement expenditure within budget and included in the FY04-FY09 Capital Improvement Program Budget. Funds in the amount of \$5,445 are available from 2000A Issued Certificates of Obligation funds and authorized payable to Site Specifics.

COORDINATION

This ordinance was coordinated with the City Attorney's Office, the Office of Management and Budget, and the Finance Department.
