BACKGROUND INFORMATON

The Canvassing Authority will meet on Friday, November 7, 2003 to review the unofficial results tabulated for the City's Special election. The Canvassing Authority's role, as authorized by the City Council, is to review the results of the election and to determine the number of under-votes for each precinct. The report presented to City Council will reflect total votes cast per precinct within each of the City Council districts for each of the 5 bond propositions.

POLICY ANALYSIS

In accordance with Section 67.003 of the State Election Code, a local entity is responsible for canvassing its election results not earlier than the third day or later than the sixth day after the election.
