SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This Ordinance approves Field Alteration No. 6 in the amount of \$32,550.00 and amends the contract of SIA Engineering, Inc. d/b/a ALL Construction Company, and authorizes additional construction contingency in the amount of \$25,000.00 in connection with the Henry A. Guerra Branch Library Project, a 1999 General Obligation Library Improvement Bond project located in Council District 6.

Staff recommends approval of this Ordinance.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

This project provides for the construction of a new 15,000 square foot library facility located at 7978 S.W. Military Drive and includes site development, landscaping, parking for 64 vehicles, future growth, controlled entry/exit, book stacks, reading and staff areas with a community meeting room, on-site detention pond and includes the coordination of pedestrian circulation between the facility, a local church and elderly housing. The project construction is underway and is scheduled to be completed in March of 2004.

The construction contract was approved by City Council on January 30, 2003, by Ordinance Number 97119 and initially authorized \$1,768,701.00 for construction services related to this project. Previously approved Field Alterations totaling \$75,035.51 increased the total contract award to \$1,843,736.51. This Council action approves the addition of \$32,550.00 to the contract amount for the Mill and Overlay of Military Drive West to repair street cuts made for the installation of water lines for the library and will adjust the final contract amount to \$1,876,286.51.

POLICY ANALYSIS

Approval of this ordinance will be a continuation of City Policy to complete previously approved Library Improvement Bond and CDBG funded projects.

FISCAL IMPACT

This is a one-time capital improvement expenditure and not included in the FY 04-09 Capital Improvement Program Budget. Funds in the amount of \$57,550.00 are available from 1999 General Obligation Library Improvement Bonds and are authorized payable as follows:

\$32,550.00	Payable to SIA Engineering, Inc. d/b/a ALL Construction Company;
\$25,000.00	Payable for miscellaneous construction contingency.

COORDINATION

This action was coordinated with the Office of Management and Budget, the Library Department, the Housing and Community Development Department and the Finance Department.

SUPPLEMENTARY COMMENTS

This contract was developed using the formal competitive bid process; therefore, a Discretionary Contracts Disclosure Form is not required for this amendment.

\$32,550.00	0 Days	Asphalt Paving Replacement @ Military Drive: Additional costs in the amount of THIRTY-TWO THOUSAND FIVE-HUNDRED FIFTY and NO/100 (\$32,550.00) are associated with the asphalt removal and replacement at Military Drive as directed by City Right-of-Way Managers. Four separate water taps will be made along Military Drive in order to install two fire hydrants, one domestic water meter, and one irrigation system meter. The City Right-of-Way Managers have determined that the existing condition of Military Drive West is sound and smooth, thus precluding the option of installing asphalt patches over the four separate trenches. An 18,600 square foot area of Military Drive West will be removed and replaced with 300 linear feet of new paving. This new paving section will better match the existing paving in terms of both appearance and performance.
		During the design process, the potential for asphalt replacement was anticipated due to recent precedents on similar projects. A unit price (\$1.75 per square foot) was established during the bidding period as outlined by the Contract Documents and submitted by the General Contractor. This unit price was used to generate the overall costs outlined in the attached exhibits.



SECTION 01026 - UNIT PRICES

PART 1 - GENERAL

1.1 RELATED DOCUMENTS

A. Drawings and general provisions of the Contract, including General and Supplementary Conditions and other Division 1 Specification Sections, apply to this Section.

1.2 SUMMARY

- A. This Section includes administrative and procedural requirements for unit prices.
- B. Related Sections: The following Sections contain requirements that relate to this Section:
 - 1. Division 1 Section "Modification Procedures" for procedures for submitting and handling Change Orders.
 - 2. Division 1 Section "Quality Control Services" for general inspection requirements.
 - Division 2 Section "Drilled Piers" for procedures for measurement for payment for greater or lesser depths for drilled piers, removal of rock or boulders obstructions encountered during pier excavations and steel casing as required.

1.3 DEFINITIONS

A. Unit price is an amount proposed by bidders, stated on the Bid Form, as a price per unit of measurement for materials or services added to or deducted from the Contract Sum by appropriate modification, if the estimated quantities of Work required by the Contract Documents are increased or decreased.

1.4 PROCEDURES

- A. Unit prices include all necessary material, plus cost for delivery, installation, insurance, overhead, profit, and applicable taxes.
- B. Measurement and Payment: Refer to individual Specification Sections for work that requires establishment of unit prices. Methods of measurement and payment for unit prices are specified in those Sections.
- C. The Owner reserves the right to reject the Contractor's measurement of work-in-place that involves use of established unit prices, and to have this work measured, at the Owner's expense, by an independent surveyor acceptable to the Contractor.
- D. Schedule: A "Unit Price Schedule" is included at the end of this Section. Specification Sections referenced in the Schedule contain requirements for materials described under each unit price.

A. Unit Price No. 1 - Rock Excavation:

- Description: Rock excavation according to Division 2 Section "Concrete Piers."
- 2. Unit of Measurement: Cu. yard of rock excavated.

B. Unit Price No. 2 - Concrete Piers:

- 1. Description: Change in length of pier from lengths indicated according to Division 2 Section "Concrete Piers."
- 2. Unit of Measurement: Linear foot of excavation, steel reinforcing and concrete in place.

C. Unit Price No. 3 - Casings:

- 1. Description: Casings required according to Division 2 Section " Concrete Piers."
- 2. Unit of Measurement: Linear foot of depth of casings and price per pier.

D. Unit Price No. 4 – New Concrete Sidewalk:

- 1. Description: The complete preparation of subgrade and complete installation of 4" thick concrete sidewalk as detailed in Civil drawings, in locations as directed by the Owner or the City of San Antonio Building Inspection's.
- Unit of Measurement: Square foot of 4" thick concrete sidewalk per the standard detail of the Construction documents.

E. Unit Price No. 5 - Asphalt Paving Replacement @ Street:

- 1. Description: the complete removal, preparation of subgrade and existing adjacent conditions required for the complete installation of asphalt pavement section, to match existing street pavement section, located within the public right-of-way as directed and/or required by the City of San Antonio.
- 2. Unit of Measurement: Square foot section of asphalt pavement per City of San Antonio's Standards.
