SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This ordinance accepts two Permanent Drainage Easement Dedications from HTS-San Antonio, L.P., a Delaware limited partnership doing business in Texas as HTS-Hyatt San Antonio, L.P.; and three Permanent Drainage Easement Dedications from Legacy Trails Development Joint Venture, a Texas joint venture, in connection with the Hyatt Hill Country Third Nine Golf Course Off-Site Drainage Project location in Council District 6.

Staff recommends the approval of this ordinance.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

There are five parcels of land being donated to the City of San Antonio. HTS-San Antonio, L.P. will donate two parcels of land consisting of two 50-foot drainage easements. Legacy Trails Development Joint Venture will donate three parcels of land consisting of one variable width drainage easement, and two 50-foot drainage easements.

There are three public drains that are proposed for this project, two within a 50-foot easement and one within a variable width drainage easement. The public drains that are proposed will convey off-site water across the proposed new golf course from upstream properties that will be developed. The developer is seeking to construct the improvements now in order prevent disturbance of the golf course in the future. Pape-Dawson Engineers, Inc., the engineers for the developer, have met with the Public Works Stormwater Engineering Division to review the proposed drainage improvements.

POLICY ANALYSIS

The acceptance of the five Permanent Drainage Easement Dedications is in the best interest of the public and the City of San Antonio.

FISCAL IMPACT

No funds are to be expended in this ordinance.

COORDINATION

This ordinance was coordinated with the City Attorney's Office, the Storm Water Engineering Division of Public Works, and Pape-Dawson Engineers, Incorporated.
