SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This ordinance authorizes the transfer of \$42,302.84 in interest income from the Carver Cultural Center Endowment Fund to the Carver Community Cultural Center Trust Fund in support of the Carver Center's performance events and operational season.

Staff recommends the approval of this ordinance.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Carver Community Cultural Center, a City facility and a special project of the Department of Community Initiatives, is a leading multicultural performing arts and education institution serving the San Antonio metropolitan area and South Texas. The City supports the Carver Community Cultural Center through Hotel/Motel Tax Funds and the General Fund for the purpose of providing affordable cultural enrichment awareness opportunities to the citizens of San Antonio.

The Carver Development Board (CDB) was established in 1987 as a 501(c)(3) organization to exclusively benefit the Carver Community Cultural Center through the solicitation and acceptance of grant awards, donations and other fund raising activities. The City authorizes an annual management services contract, by which the CDB provides guidance and governance relationship to the Carver Center. The City in collaboration with the CDB has a 15-year history of bringing the residents of San Antonio quality cultural performing arts presentations and enriching the community through other arts educational opportunities.

The Carver Community Cultural Center Endowment Fund was created under the National Endowment for the Arts Challenge Grant federal requirements as a permanent endowment fund authorized by Ordinance No. 80699 on September 1, 1994. The principal on the Endowment Fund is held in perpetuity in an interest bearing account for the Carver Center.

POLICY ANALYSIS

Ordinance No. 80699, passed and approved on September 1, 1994, requires that interest from the Endowment Fund be for the sole and exclusive benefit of supporting the operations of the Carver Community Cultural Center. These funds support the Carver Center's performance events and operational season. This ordinance is a continuation of existing city policy to enable the Carver Community Cultural Center to fulfill its mission.

FISCAL IMPACT

This action transfers \$42,302.84 in interest income from the Carver Cultural Center Endowment Fund. This transfer will create a small surplus (\$161) in the Carver's Trust Fund (Attachment A). Although FY 03 did result in a General Fund operating deficit for the Carver Center due, primarily, to lagging ticket sales at main stage performances, the Department has worked in close partnership with the Board to develop a fiscal plan to improve operations during the current and future years. DCI has worked with the Board to ensure that there are sufficient accounting and fiscal controls in place to monitor the operating budget that was developed jointly by the Board and DCI.

COORDINATION

Coordination of activities has occurred with the City Attorney's Office, Finance Department, Office of Management and Budget, and the Carver Development Board.

SUPPLEMENTARY COMMENTS

Provisions of the Ethics Ordinance do not apply.
