SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This ordinance authorizes the City of San Antonio to accept a \$319,924 allocation from the Bexar Metro 911 Network District for Fiscal Year 2003-2004 for funding of five temporary call taker positions, communication equipment maintenance, equipment purchases, and training.

Staff recommends approval.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Revenue for the Bexar Metro 911 District is collected through an emergency service fee on each telephone in the three county area (Bexar, Comal, and Guadalupe counties). The Bexar Metro 911 District has provided funding to pay for five call taker positions and operations support consisting of training for communications personnel, and maintenance for the Uninterrupted Power Source (UPS) for the City of San Antonio's 911 operations. The Bexar Metro 911 district was established in 1985 and authorized as a taxing entity via an election in January of 1987. Funds collected are from monthly fees on telephones and consist of a \$0.22 for a land line and \$0.50 per cellular phone.

POLICY ANALYSIS

The proposed ordinance continues City Council's policy of seeking intergovernmental financial assistance for City crime prevention and enforcement programs addressing personal and property crimes activity. The allocation will be used to fund five call taker positions, operating expenses, and communication equipment maintenance consisting of the UPS for the Public Safety Answering Point (PSAP).

FISCAL IMPACT

The proposed project budget totals \$319,924. The allocation does not require a City match.

COORDINATION

This ordinance request has been coordinated with Finance, City Attorney's Office, and the Office of Management and Budget.
