Ordinance authorizing the expenditure of \$8,600 for Fee Simple Title to four

parcels in connection with the Salado Creek Greenway (Hike & Bike) project

#### SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This ordinance authorizes funds in the amount of \$8,600 payable to Lawyers Title of San Antonio as escrow agent for Annie Winters, Charles W. Smith, Rachel Ann Rhyne, and Sterling Allen, for Fee Simple Title to four parcels of land (\$8,000), Right of Entry Fee (\$100), and Title Fees (\$500), in connection with the Salado Creek Greenway (Hike & Bike) project located in Council District 2. This is an authorized 1999 Flood Control with Parks Improvements Bond project.

Staff recommends the approval of this ordinance.

#### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

There are eight signed instruments and two condemned parcels in the 25-parcel project. The Real Estate Section was directed to acquire ten of the fee simple title parcels and Pape-Dawson Engineers, Inc., has been contracted for the acquisition of the 15 permanent easement parcels. Advertisement is scheduled for May 2004, with construction to begin in July 2004, and scheduled to be completed in July 2005.

#### **POLICY ANALYSIS**

The acquisition of this property is necessary to complete this real estate transaction in this project.

#### **FISCAL IMPACT**

This is a one-time capital expenditure within budget and included in the FY04-FY09 Capital Improvement Program Budget. Funds in the amount of \$8,600 are available from 1999 Flood Control & Park Improvement Bonds and authorized payable to Lawyers Title of San Antonio.

#### **COORDINATION**

This ordinance was coordinated with the City Attorney's Office, the Finance Department, the Office of Management and Budget, the Parks and Recreation Department.
