### SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This ordinance accepts the low, responsive bid and awards a construction contract in the amount of \$345,256.10 payable to Pronto Sandblasting & Coating & Oil Field Service Co., Inc., a MBE firm, and authorizes \$25,200.65 for construction contingency expenses for an overall total of \$370,456.75, in connection with Northington: SW 36<sup>th</sup> to SW 35<sup>th</sup> project, a 1999 General Obligation Street Improvement Bond Project located in Council District 1. Of the \$370,456.75 total amount, \$277,207.15 will be funded by General Obligations of the City and \$93,249.60 will be funded by San Antonio Water System (SAWS).

Staff recommends approval of this ordinance.

### BACKGROUND INFORMATION

This project includes the reconstruction of Northington from SW 36<sup>th</sup> to SW 35<sup>th</sup> Street to a 27-foot width. The project will include parkway improvements such as curbs, sidewalks and driveway approaches, as well as necessary drainage and utility improvements. This project is scheduled to begin construction in January 2004 and to be completed by August 2004.

This Project was advertised for construction bids in the Commercial Recorder, the San Antonio Informer, and La Prensa in November 2003. In addition, the bid announcement was made on TVSA, through the SBEDA Office and Dodge Report. Plans were also available for review by potential bidders in the Public Works Office.

Bids for the Project were opened on November 5, 2003 with three (3) bidders responding. A matrix reflecting the outcome of the bid process is attached.

The Economic Development Department has reviewed and approved the Good Faith Effort Plan submitted by Pronto Sandblasting and Coating. The contractor is a certified MBE firm and does not anticipate having any subcontractors. The contract provides for one hundred ten (110) calendar days to complete the project. Pronto Sandblasting and Coating currently has one contract with the City of San Antonio through the Public Works Department on the Givens – 200 to 500 Block (Midway to IH-35) project in the amount of \$280,268.

### **POLICY ANALYSIS**

Approval of this ordinance will be a continuation of City Council policy to complete previously approved 1999 General Obligation Street Improvement Bond projects.

### **FISCAL IMPACT**

This is a one-time capital improvement expenditure within budget and included in the FY 04-09 Capital Improvement Program Budget. Funds in the amount of \$141,000.00 are available from 1999 General Obligation Street Improvement Bonds, \$136,207.15 are available from 2002 Certificates of Obligation, and \$93,249.60 will be funded by SAWS for a total of \$370,456.75 authorized payable as follows:

### **COORDINATION**

This request for ordinance has been coordinated with the Office of Management and Budget and the Finance Department.

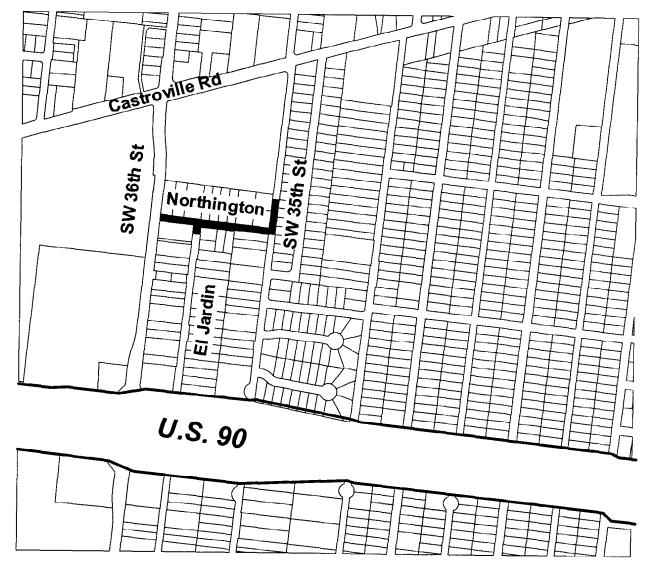
