SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This ordinance acknowledges a contract modification by Alamo Workforce Development Inc. (AWD) awarding Workforce Investment Act (WIA) funds in the amount of \$200,000 for the provision of child care services and operations in connection with the Alamo Child Care Delivery System (CCDS) program during the period of September 1, 2003 through August 31, 2004. This ordinance also adopts a revised CCDS program budget.

Staff recommends approval of this ordinance.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Texas Workforce Commission (TWC) is responsible for administering the State's childcare program. TWC contracts the responsibility for the integrated delivery of TWC programs, which include child care and WIA programs, to local workforce development boards throughout the state. AWD is the local workforce board that serves Bexar and the 11 surrounding counties. The City of San Antonio, Department of Community Initiatives' (DCI) Children's Resources Division (CRD) is contracted by AWD to operate the Alamo CCDS program.

CRD provides overall CCDS coordination, client services, fiscal management, and vendor management. CRD also provides qualified participants with eligibility and certification services, counseling on the selection of quality childcare and referrals to all participating childcare facilities from which parents may select to meet their individual child care needs.

AWD has made additional WIA funds available for the provision of child care services, which will serve approximately 59 additional children whose parents are participating in Workforce Investment Act activities. Specifically, WIA programs serve as a resource to dislocated workers and other individuals in support of workforce preparation and other employment readiness services. AWD contracts with SER Jobs for Progress to operate the Bexar County workforce centers, and the Alamo Area Development Corporation to operate the rural area centers, which includes the provision of WIA program services. Upon determining WIA eligibility, workforce centers refer clients to CCDS for childcare services while enrolled and participating in a WIA program.

The Alamo CCDS program represents multiple level partnerships and maximizes the program's capacity through the expertise of its partners. Family Service Association and the City of San Antonio coordinate the Quality Improvement Activities (QIA) component that includes training and enhancements as well as the provision of equipment and materials to service providers. The City and the Alamo Area Development Corporation provide child care and vendor management services to facilitate the service delivery system between urban and rural areas. The Texas Legislative Budget Board (LBB) sets accountability measures for programs administered through the Texas Workforce Commission and the Local Workforce Development Boards (LWDBs). For the Alamo CCDS program, the following accountability measures and standards for fiscal year 2003–2004 were assigned:

POLICY ANALYSIS

Pursuant to Ordinance No. 98090, passed and approved on August 28, 2003, City Council authorized the operation of the Alamo CCDS program from September 1, 2003 to August 31, 2005. This ordinance is a continuation of existing City polices to administer the CCDS program through funding from AWD and TWC, and to coordinate with the LWDB to identify and offer local services and funding in support of human development initiatives. This ordinance also reflects a continuation of existing policy supporting the City's Human Development core issue of Early Childhood Education and Family Strengthening.

FISCAL IMPACT

This ordinance acknowledges a unilateral contract modification by AWD and authorizes the acceptance of WIA funds in the amount of \$200,000 for the provision of childcare services for WIA participants in connection with the CCDS program. This ordinance also adopts a revised CCDS program budget.

A summary of budget revisions to the CCDS program is as follows:
