SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This ordinance amends the San Antonio Police Department's General Fund budget by authorizing the transfer of \$209,108 to fund four (4) new Caseworker II positions, four (4) new Police Officer positions, and four administrative vehicles, to staff additional Crisis Response Teams (CRT) at the Police Department's substations.

Staff recommends approval.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

In September 2003, the San Antonio Police Department's Victims Advocacy Section applied for a grant from the Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA). The grant was to fund a victims service program over a four year period with an emphasis on children. Funding was to have been \$400,000 per year over a four-year period. The Police Department was notified that it had not been awarded the grant in October 2003.

During the adoption of the City's budget, Council set a special allocation aside to fund additional CRTs if the SAMHSA grant was not secured. This allocation was earmarked for \$450,000 to allow the Police Department to develop a program to meet the needs of the Victims Advocacy Section.

The mission of the Crisis Response Teams (CRTs) is to provide services to individuals affected by domestic violence as well as other violent crimes. It supports the mission and goals of the Police Department through the integration of expertise from experienced community-oriented policing officers and professional caseworkers who provide short-term crisis intervention, mental health assistance, referrals to appropriate resources and advocacy services. CRTs are an innovative pairing of police officer and social services provider as a team. They can bring both

law-enforcement and social service resources together to accomplish the mission. The following table reflects current and proposed staffing after the additions:

With the addition of the four new caseworkers and four Police Officers each substation will be staffed with a minimum of two full CRTs. Work hours will be expanded to provide for CRT coverage for 12 hours a day (7:45 a.m. - 7:45 p.m.) Monday through Friday.

POLICY ANALYSIS

This Ordinance continues City Council's policy of providing coordinated services to victims of violent crime. The CRTs were item No. 36 of tier 1 on the City Council Priority Ranking List for the FY 2004 budget process. A presentation of this issue was made to the Council Quality of Life Committee on February 5, 2004 and recommended to be forwarded for full Council consideration.

FISCAL IMPACT

Four new civilian positions (Caseworker II) and four new Police Officer positions will be added to the San Antonio Police Department's authorized staffing level as well as four administrative vehicles and related equipment for officers and caseworkers. The new CRTs will use existing office space and equipment already at the substations.

First year costs are estimated at \$209,108 based on the funding of positions for 5 months. Funding for this is included in the City's FY04 General Fund budget and will be transferred from the Special One-Time Projects budget to the Police Department's General Fund budget. The amount originally allocated is \$450,000, therefore, the balance of \$240,892 will be carried over to Fiscal Year 2005. Second year funding based on a full year is estimated at \$449,551. As a result, an additional \$208,659 will be required to fully fund the initiative in Fiscal Year 2005. By authorizing these positions this Fiscal Year, an unplanned requirement of \$208,659 will be created in the Fiscal Year 2005 Budget. This unplanned budget requirement was not included in the Fiscal Year 2005 shortfall projection.

COORDINATION

This ordinance request has been coordinated with Finance, City Attorney, and the Office of Management & Budget.
