#### **SUMMARY & RECOMMENDATION:**

This ordinance authorizes the Purchasing & General Services Department to accept the low responsive bid submitted by Utility Trailer Sales Southeast Texas, Inc. to provide the City of San Antonio Public Works Department with half round end dump trailers. Staff recommends approval of this ordinance.

#### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION:**

The attached tabulation of four bids to provide the City of San Antonio Public Works Department with three 30 cubic yard half round, end dump trailers is hereby submitted for council consideration and action. The low responsive bid was submitted by Utility Trailer Sales Southeast Texas Inc.

These trailers will be mounted onto 52,000 GVWR cab and chassis previously purchased and utilized to haul sand, gravel and asphalt for repair and resurfacing of streets throughout the city. The life expectancy of these units is 10 years. This equipment is being purchased in conjunction with the Street Trucking Efficiency/Productivity Enhancement Program approved in the FY2004 Budget, which dedicated funds toward improving the efficiency and capacity of street maintenance performed with city crews.

Previously, smaller (7 or 10 cubic yard) trucks were utilized which hauled less and required more frequent pickup of material. With the use of these larger 30 cubic yard trailers, the number of haul loads will be greatly reduced as well as the number of times the asphalt is handled, increasing the quality of the material. These trailers are constructed with rigid steel frames that give them the capability to haul heavy duty construction and demolition materials, as well as assist with rear dumping in uneven areas. With the use of the larger units, it is anticipated that in one full year of operation productivity will be increased by 15% - 20%.

## POLICY ANALYSIS

This contract will provide the Public Works Department with 3 half round end dump trailers. This equipment is covered by a one-year warranty on parts and labor. Initial training will be coordinated by the successful vendor to demonstrate the safe operation of the units.

#### **FINANCIAL IMPACT:**

The total cost of this contract is \$79,317.00. Funding will be from the Miscellaneous Special Revenue Fund-Streets/Drainage Maintenance and Improvements. All expenditures will be in accordance with the FY2003-2004 Budget approved by City Council.
