necessary, and payment of miscellaneous expenses associated with the French

Creek Buyout Project

SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATION

This ordinance authorizes 2003 Storm Water Revenue Bond funds in the amount of \$2,562,750 for fee simple title to certain privately owned real property and other miscellaneous expenses associated with the French Creek Buyouts - South of Prue Road project, an authorized 2003 Storm Water Revenue Bond project located in Council District 7. This ordinance authorizes City staff to acquire these properties at fair market value by negotiation or condemnation, if necessary.

Staff recommends the approval of this ordinance.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

There are eight parcels to acquire in this project. The City of San Antonio has determined that regional storm water management is preferable to site specific storm water mitigation. Regional storm water management uses a watershed-wide approach to analyze potential flooding problems. The regional solution that has been selected to solve flooding issues is to acquire certain properties that are within the 100 year flood plain areas. When these properties are acquired they will be returned to a natural floodplain state. The acquisition will prevent any future catastrophic losses to property during heavy rain events.

POLICY ANALYSIS

This ordinance will streamline the process for acquiring the right of way for this project and the payment of the miscellaneous expenses associated with this project.

FISCAL IMPACT

This is a one-time capital improvement expenditure within budget and included in the FY04-FY09 Capital Improvement Program Budget. Funds in the amount of \$2,562,750 are available from 2003 Storm Water Revenue Bonds.

COORDINATION

This ordinance was coordinated with the City Attorney's Office, the Finance Department, the Office of Management and Budget, and the Public Works Storm Water Engineering Division.

SUPPLEMENTARY COMMENTS









Lots to be Acquired 17721 Parcel No.
