SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATION

This ordinance authorizes the closure of certain streets in connection with Fiesta 2004, approves the conditions, dates and times for specified Fiesta events, approves the location, dates and times for the Fiesta Carnival and related requirements and conditions, and approves the Fiesta Parade routes.

Staff recommends approval of this annual ordinance.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The following Fiesta events and street closures are approved for the dates and times as outlined below:

SOUTHWEST SCHOOL OF ART AND CRAFT FIESTA ARTS FAIR:

FRIDAY, APRIL 16^{TH} , 8:00 A.M. TO 6:00 P.M. and SUNDAY, APRIL 18^{TH} , 5:00 P.M. TO 8:00 P.M.

Augusta between Navarro and Giraud closed to through traffic.

Augusta between Giraud and Convent open to **one-way** traffic **southbound** to allow parking on the east side of Augusta.

Police officers stationed at all times at Augusta & Giraud and at Augusta & Convent.

SATURDAY, APRIL 17TH, 9:00 A.M. TO 6:00 P.M. and

SUNDAY, APRIL 18TH, 11:00 A.M. TO 5:00 P.M.

Augusta between Navarro and Giraud closed to ALL traffic.

Augusta between Giraud and Convent open to two-way traffic.

Police officers stationed at all times at Augusta & Navarro and at Augusta & Giraud.

Both off-duty officers will be required to direct vehicular and pedestrian traffic, and must be at their posted locations throughout the entire duration of the requested street closures. The daily placement and daily removal of all traffic control devices shall only be done by the certified barricade company, at the expense of the event sponsor. Augusta Street from Convent to Navarro shall be open to two-way traffic during non-event hours.

NIGHT IN OLD SAN ANTONIO:

Presa St. The following streets will be closed beginning Saturday, April 17, 2004 at 8:30 a.m. to 12:00 noon on Sunday, April 25, 2004; South Presa Street from Market Street to Nueva Street. South Presa Street from Nueva St. to Arcienga St will be made a one-way southbound during event hours only. Access to Villita Assembly Hall will be maintained for participants in the "Patriotic and Historic Ball" on Saturday evening April 19, 2004.

Alamo St. The southbound lane of Alamo St. between Market and Nueva Streets shall be closed to thru traffic April 20, 2004 to April 23, 2004 between the hours of 4:00 p.m. to 12:00 midnight. Access to the Hilton Hotel shall remain open and a temporary northbound lane shall be established for Hilton two-way traffic ingress and egress. The southbound curblane of Alamo St. between Villita and Nueva

St. excluding the area in front of the southbound VIA bus shelter at S. Alamo and Nueva streets from Saturday, April 17, 2004 8:30 a.m. through Sunday, April 25, 2004 12:00 noon;

Nueva St. The following streets will be closed beginning Saturday, April 17, 2004 at 8:30 a.m. to 12:00 noon on Sunday, April 25, 2004: the median and west bound lanes of Nueva Street from South Alamo Street to 175 feet west of South Presa Street; The east bound lanes of Nueva St. from Presa St. to Alamo St. shall be closed to thru traffic from April 20, 2004 to April 23, 2004 between the hours of 8:00 p.m. to 12:00 midnight. Vehicular access to the Fairmount Hotel shall remain open.

River Walk Areas: NIOSA is approved to expand the controlled area during event hours only, to include the Bombach walkway in-between the Little Rhein Steakhouse and the Hilton Palacio Hotel leading from S. Alamo street walkway down to the river walk area. NIOSA may also erect two (2) gate locations beginning at 4:30 p.m. until 10:30 p.m. each event night along the south bank of the river walk at (1) the Hilton/Little Rhein sidewalk landing, and (2) at a point approximately fifty (50) feet west of the Arneson River Theater Iron Gate, also on the south bank of the San Antonio river.

FIESTA FANTASIAS AT MARKET SQUARE: San Saba Street from Dolorosa to West Commerce Street closed entirely to include sidewalks and the roadway from 9:00 a.m. on Tuesday, April 13, 2004 through 6:00 p.m. on Monday April 26, 2004.

During the closure of San Saba St. between Dolorosa and W. Commerce St. a certified peace officer will be required to man the traffic barricides during the following dates and times:

Tuesday April 13, 2004 to Thursday, April 15, 2004 from 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 p.m. each day.

Friday, April 16, 2004 to Monday April 26, 2004 from 7:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m., each day.

NO SIDEWALKS OR TRAFFIC LANES SHALL BE CLOSED AT ANY OTHER PERIOD OTHER THAN THE DATE AND TIME INDICATED BY THIS ORDINANCE.

Fiesta Fantasias Approved Event Hours of Operation (Reference City Ordinance 98642):

April 16 - 23, 2004: 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 midnight

April 24, 2004: 10:00 a.m. to 1:00 a.m. April 25, 2004: 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 a.m.

Pecos Street: The area from the "Tour Bus Loading Zone" to the temporary fence erected under IH-35 ramp shall be used for parking <u>by permit only</u> as issued by the City of San Antonio Public Works Department, for Market Square vehicles relating to the Fiesta Fantasias event. Parking on Gateway Plaza must limit vehicles to ¾ ton pickups or smaller in size. A band stage and a large trailer for the speaker system can be provided, but the semi-tractor rig and other associated non-conforming vehicles must be elsewhere. Parking on City sidewalks and Gateway Plaza and other Plaza pedestrian walkways <u>WILL NOT BE AUTHORIZED AND STRICTLY ENFORCED BY SAPD AND PUBLIC WORKS PARKING ENFORCEMENT PERSONNEL</u>.

Approved Vendor Service Vehicle Parking: Commercial vendor's service vehicles with a valid affixed commercial placard and displayed valid parking permit (parking meter bag) issued by the City of San Antonio (Public Works Traffic Engineering) will be authorized to park at the following locations:

On the west bound, south curb lane of W. Commerce between Santa Rosa and San Saba Streets (6 band vehicles or trucks)

On the west bound, south curb lane of W. Commerce between Pecos and Leona Streets (2 trucks)

On the north bound, east curb lane of San Saba just north of Dolorosa (1-trailer)

On the west curb lane of San Saba between Commerce and Houston (1-trailer, 2-vehicles)

On north side of Dolorosa between San Saba and Santa Rosa (1-trailer, 2-trucks)

On north side of Dolorosa from San Saba to Santa Rosa between the hours of 7:00 am to 3:00 pm on weekdays and 7:00 am to 9:00 am weekends.

On the west curb lane of San Saba between Dolorosa and Nueva. (Band vehicles only)

The serving, loading and/or unloading of any parked trailers on Dolorosa Street during event operations will be hereby prohibited and violators will be towed at owner's expense.

Each year, the City's carnival concessionaire is required to provide security at City Hall, maintain operating standards and policies as required, and ensure that revenue and cleanup minimums are maintained. For Fiesta 2004, Reed Exposition Midway (Reed) has committed to comply with all terms and conditions of the agreement City staff shall continue the practice of meeting with Reed management prior to carnival operations to verify the price of all ride and food items for contract compliance. The map for the Fiesta 2004 Carnival and Parade sites are attached in the accompanying ordinance.

POLICY ANALYSIS

Approval of this ordinance will allow for the timely planning, coordination and development of the Fiesta San Antonio events for 2004 in accordance with the adopted agreement between the City of San Antonio and the Fiesta Commission.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

This is the third of a three (3) year contract between the Fiesta Commission and Reed Expositions Midways (Reed). This contract may be extended for two (2) more additional years if approved by the City. For all three years of the initial term and the two (2) option years if applicable, the annual minimum guaranteed is \$750,000 or 35% of gross revenues, whichever is greater. For the minimum percentage of 35% to be initiated, approximately \$2.14 million in gross revenue must be realized. Reed reported \$1.26 million in gross revenues for Fiesta 2003 a decrease from the \$1.54 million reported for Fiesta 2002 with this reduction due inpart to the 2003 Easter Holiday.

The \$750,000 guaranteed minimum from Reed is distributed between the City and the Fiesta Commission by a formula that provides that the City receive a minimum of \$150,000 and the Fiesta Commission \$600,000. The City received \$150,000 for Fiesta 2002.

The annual City expenditures for Fiesta San Antonio historically have been approximately \$900,000. The City provides police officers for traffic control and security at some Fiesta events. The City also provides inspectors, but concessionaires are required to pay the inspection fees as set in the annual budget. Revenues are received from Fiesta sponsors by separate contractual arrangements for rental of city facilities. The Cattleman Square Parking Lot will not be used as an additional site for carnival operations or the Market Square Fiesta event.

COORDINATION

These events have been coordinated with the City Manager's Office, the Police Department, the Fire Department, the Public Works Department, the Parks & Recreation Department, the Metropolitan Health District, the City Attorney's Office, the Fiesta Commission and Reed Exposition Midways. All of the involved organizations concur with the staff recommendation to approve this request.




Approved 2004 Fiesta en la villa de San Fernando Site Map





2004 Carnival Site Required Fire Lanes








