SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS:

This ordinance will approve the parade permit and authorize the temporary closure of certain streets in connection with the Police Officer Memorial Run being held on Saturday, May 22, 2004. The run/walk will assemble and disband at Ave. B between Josephine and Pearl Pkwy. The route is attached.

Staff recommends approval of this ordinance.

POLICY ANALYSIS:

This ordinance is consistent with the City policy requiring an ordinance where closures of public streets are requested.

COORDINATION:


