D. MUNICIPAL CIVIL SERVICE COMMISSION


An ordinance to amend the expiration term date for Mr. Isidro Cardenas who was appointed on August 21, 2003. Term of office will expire on June 6, 2005.

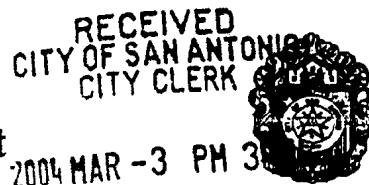
