SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This ordinance authorizes the City Manager or her designated representative to accept an Office of National Drug Control Policy (ONDCP) High Intensity Drug Trafficking Area (HIDTA) Grant in the amount of \$2,033,568. This grant funds the San Antonio HIDTA Initiative, which consists of the Multi-Agency Drug Courier & Apprehension Task Force, the South Texas Intelligence Center, and the Director's Administrative Support Element. The grant period is January 1, 2004 to December 31, 2004.

Staff recommends approval.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The HIDTA mission is to reduce drug trafficking in the San Antonio metropolitan area by instituting innovative narcotic enforcement investigations and the seizure of illegally obtained assets in an effort to reduce the profitability of narcotics trafficking.

The Multi-Agency Drug Courier & Apprehension Task Force is designed to enhance the Police Department's narcotics enforcement efforts by allowing the unit to utilize the task force concept to target narcotics organizations and interdiction efforts. A task force provides the capability to cross-jurisdictional boundaries by employing law enforcement officers from the local, state, and federal levels. This grant targets the organizational aspects of the narcotics organizations by focusing on middle to upper level traffickers and conducting investigations of drug distribution and related enterprises. Members of this unit are trained to develop investigations in the area of money laundering, asset structuring, financial auditing, and surveillance techniques necessary to arrest offenders and develop intelligence.

The South Texas Intelligence Center has a two-fold responsibility. The center will respond to inquiries from San Antonio and surrounding counties' criminal justice agencies by providing timely intelligence reports gathered from databases of the respective member agencies.

Secondly, the center will act as a de-confliction unit for South Texas, which covers the area from Bexar County, south to Brownsville, and west to Del Rio. This section of the center is of paramount importance relative to officer safety. It will be responsible for maintaining up to date information gathered from all law enforcement agencies operating in South Texas. Utilizing information provided by these agencies, the unit will identify potential conflicts involving officer safety and immediately notify the affected agencies of the potential conflict in order to avoid possible tragic and disastrous consequences.

Since the Director's Administrative Support Element is responsible for the overall administration and operation of the South Texas HIDTA program, funds will be utilized for the rental of facilities for the director's office.

Fiscal Year 2004 is the eighth year that this grant has been awarded to the San Antonio Police Department. For FY2004 the total HIDTA budget is \$2,033,568, which is a \$9,976 increase over last year's budget. Grant funds a total of nineteen (19) positions (see attached personnel complement). This is a decrease of one position from last year. Due to the new contract between the San Antonio Police Officers' Association and the City of San Antonio, and the increase in operating costs for the grant (rental of facilities, lease of vehicles, etc.), the \$9,976 funding increase was insufficient to fund the grant at its current level. Because of this a detective position was eliminated from the grant. This position will be eliminated through attrition caused by retirement. This grant serves the law enforcement agencies for San Antonio and surrounding counties.

Although the grant period is January 1, 2004 through December 31, 2004, the Congressional budget approval process delayed receipt of the award letters until after the starting date of the grant.

POLICY ANALYSIS

This Ordinance continues City Council's policy of seeking intergovernmental financial assistance for City crime prevention and enforcement programs addressing drug crime activity. This program will enhance the City's efforts in dealing with narcotics trafficking.

FISCAL IMPACT

The program budget for the twelve-month period totals \$2,033,568. A General Fund match is not required (see attached Budget).

COORDINATION

This ordinance request has been coordinated with the Finance Department, City Attorney's Office, and the Office of Management & Budget.
