SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATION:

A request for five (5) firework displays was received on behalf of the San Antonio Mission's Baseball team and Alpha-Lee Enterprises, Inc. They are requesting an ordinance for permission to hold these firework displays at Wolff Stadium, as additional promotions to increase attendance at baseball games. The fireworks will be discharged from an open field across Hwy 90 from Wolff stadium. This display is to be held at approximately 9:00 PM or at conclusion of game on the following Saturday dates: **May 8, June 12, June 19, July 17, and August 14, 2004.**

Michael W. McIntosh, President of Alpha-Lee Enterprises, Inc., obtained and filed all display permits and insurance requirements with the Fire Marshal's office at 115 Auditorium Circle.

Security requirements and precautions are included as conditions to display.

Staff recommends approval of this ordinance.

POLICY ANALYSIS:

This Fire Department has recommended approval of fireworks permits for functions such as this when public safety can be assured.
