Staff Recommendation:

Approval. The request conforms with the Tobin Hill Neighborhood Plan. The land use plan recommends residential use at this location. This property is located within the Housing Protection Zone designated in the plan. The Tobin Hill Neighborhood Plan, adopted in 1987, may be considered in evaluating this rezoning request, however the Zoning Commission does not need to make a finding of consistency in this case.

On February 4, 2004 the Historic Design and Review Commission (HDRC) recommended a finding of historic significance for this property. The house qualifies as a City of San Antonio Landmark according to the following criteria of the Historic and Design Section of the Unified Development Code:

A. It is a visible reminder of the cultural heritage of the community (35-607, B-1);

B. Its embodiment of disguising characteristics of an architectural style for the study of a period, type, method of construction, or use of indigenous materials (35-607, B-5);

C. Its historical, architectural, or cultural integrity of location, design, materials, and workmanship (35-607, B-8);

- D. Buildings, objects or structures which constitute a particular or unique example of an architectural type or historic period (35-607, C-c); and
- E. The building has come to represent a part of San Antonio's cultural heritage for at least twenty-five years (35-607, C-2a).

The property owner is in favor of the proposed zone change.

REQUEST:

The applicant is requesting a Certificate of Appropriateness for approval of a finding of historic significance for this property.

RECOMMENDATION:

The staff recommends approval of this request as submitted. This house was built in 1909. It is a fine example of the Victorian style with a Queen Anne influence. The property will join a number of other landmark designations in Tobin Hill and will strengthen the character of the neighborhood. The house qualifies as a City of San Antonio Landmark according to the following criteria of the Historic and Design Section of the Unified Development Code:

- (1) It is a visible reminder of the cultural heritage of the community (35-607, B-1);
- (2) Its embodiment of distinguishing characteristics of an architectural style valuable for the study of a period, type, method of construction, or use of indigenous materials

(35-607, B-5);

- (3) Its historical, architectural, or cultural integrity of location, design, materials, and workmanship (35-607, B-8);
- (4) Buildings, objects or structures which constitute a particular or unique example of an architectural type or historic period (35-607, C-1c);
- (5) The building has come to represent a part of San Antonio's cultural heritage for at least twenty-five years (35-607, C-2a).

Ann McGlone, Historic Preservation Officer, stated this house was built 1909. She stated this property was presented to the Historic Design and Review Commission on February 4, 2004 and recommended a finding of historic significance. She stated this house qualifies as a City of San Antonio Landmark according to the criteria of the Historic and Design Section of the Unified Development Code. She also stated the homeowner is in favor of this request.

Staff stated there were 26 notices mailed out to the surrounding property owners, 0 returned in opposition and 3 returned in favor and Tobin Hill Neighborhood Association and Tobin Hill Residents Association are in favor.
