SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This ordinance appropriates funds in the amount of \$254,950.00 for construction services and authorizes the City of San Antonio Public Works Department to provide construction services in connection with the reconstruction of the San Antonio Police Department Training Academy Driving Track, located at 12200 S. E. Loop 410 in City Council District 3, a capital project funded by 2002 Certificates of Obligation.

Staff recommends approval.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

2002 Certificates of Obligation authorized the funding for the San Antonio Police Department Training Academy Driving Track reconstruction project for a total of \$255,000.00. The track, which was constructed in 1988, is used for training in emergency driving situations. It is damaged from years of wear from driving and weather erosion, especially at the curves and turns. Other than the addition of an intersection, no reconstruction or viable maintenance has been done on the driving track in sixteen years. The project provides for the reconstruction of the damaged concrete slab and mill/overlay of the driving surface. The mill/overlay process entails taking up the existing asphalt, mixing in petroleum binding products and resurfacing the asphalt. The project construction budget is \$254,950.00 and construction is anticipated to begin in early June and estimated completion is July 31, 2004.

The Public Works – Streets Division, has coordinated with SAPD in developing the scope of work required for this project.

POLICY ANALYSIS

Approval of this ordinance will be a continuation of City Council policy to complete previously approved 2002 Certificates of Obligation funded Capital Improvement Projects.

FISCAL IMPACT

This is a one-time capital improvement expenditure within budget and included in the FY 2004-2009 Capital Improvement Program Budget. Funds in the amount of \$254,950.00 are available from 2002 Certificates of Obligation and are authorized payable as follows:

\$232,388.00 Payable to City Forces Account for Street Maintenance \$22,562.00 Payable to Miscellaneous Construction Contingency

This action will not impact the City's General Fund.
