### SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This ordinance accepts the low responsive bid and awards a construction contract in the amount of \$715,923.15 payable to R.L. Jones, LP, authorizes \$71,592.32 for construction contingency expenses, and \$1,000.00 for advertising expenses for an overall total of \$788,515.47 from Certificates of Obligation funds in connection with Braniff - Turbo to U.S. 281, an authorized 1994-1999 General Obligation Drainage Bond project, located in Council District 9.

Staff recommends approval of this ordinance.

### **BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

This project includes the installation of a drainage system on Braniff, Rendevous, and Turbo Drive, as well as mill and overlay as deemed necessary. This project is scheduled to begin construction in June of 2004 and to be completed by June of 2005.

This Project was advertised for construction bids in the Commercial Recorder, the San Antonio Informer, and La Prensa in March 2004. In addition, the bid announcement was made on TVSA, through the SBEDA Office and Dodge Report. Plans were also available for review by potential bidders in the Public Works Office.

Bids for the project were opened on April 14, 2004 with four (4) bidders responding. A matrix reflecting the outcome of the bid process is attached.

The Economic Development Department has reviewed and approved the Good Faith Effort Plan submitted by R.L. Jones, LP and the contractor has committed to subcontract \$159,000.00 (22.07%) to MBE firms and \$14,000.00 to AABE firms (1.94%). The Memorandum from the Economic Development Department is included herein as Attachment 3. The contract provides for one hundred fifty (150) calendar days to complete the project. R.L. Jones, LP currently has three (3) construction contracts with the City of San Antonio through the Public Works Department in the total amount of \$6,066,865.00. A current list of projects is included herein as Attachment 4.

Funds for the construction of this project in the amount of \$107,515.47 are being transferred from surplus funds identified in the Hollyhock at Huebner Creek Drainage Structure Project Budget.

### **POLICY ANALYSIS**

Approval of this ordinance will be a continuation of City Council policy to complete previously approved 1994-1999 General Obligation Drainage Improvement Bond funded Capital Improvement Projects.

### **FISCAL IMPACT**

This is a one-time capital improvement expenditure, not within budget and of the total amount of \$788,515.47, the amount of \$681,000 is included in the FY 04-09 Capital Improvement Program Budget. Funds in the amount of \$107,515.47 are available from the Hollyhock at Huebner Creek Drainage Structure Project Budget and funds in the amount of \$681,000 are available from 2002 Certificates of Obligation, and are authorized payable as follows:

\$ 715,923.15	payable to R.L. Jones, LP for construction expenses
\$ 71,592.32	payable for miscellaneous construction contingency
\$ 1,000.00	payable for advertising expenses

### **COORDINATION**

This request for ordinance has been coordinated with the Office of Management and Budget, the Economic Development Department and the Finance Department.

### **SUPPLEMENTARY COMMENTS**

This construction contract was developed utilizing the formal competitive bid process; therefore, a Discretionary Contracts Disclosure Form is not required.


