Agreement in connection with the McCullough – UPRR to Basse MPO Project

SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This ordinance accepts and authorizes an Intrajurisdictional Agreement between the City of San Antonio and the City Public Service Board (CPS), and authorizes the City Manager or her designee to execute same, in connection with the McCullough – UPRR to Basse Metropolitan Planning Organization project, an authorized 1999-2004 General Obligation Street Bond project, located in Council District 9.

Staff recommends the approval of this ordinance.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The City submitted a request to the CPS for the release of a 0.0220 acre (9,570 square feet) tract of land for additional needed right of way in connection with the McCullough – UPRR to Basse MPO project. The CPS will release such property from its use, benefit, and control, and will transfer and assign the required right of way to the City, to utilize the property for the improved right of way project or for any other municipal purposes deemed necessary by the City.

Advertisement is scheduled for December 2004 by the Texas Department of Transportation, with construction to begin in March 2005, and scheduled to be completed in December 2005. The scope of work for this project includes the reconstruction of the existing two-lane roadway on McCullough, from the Union Pacific Railroad tracks to Basse, adding a center turn lane, with curbs, six foot sidewalks at curb, bicycle accommodations and necessary drainage.

POLICY ANALYSIS

Approval of this ordinance will be a continuation of City Council policy to complete previously approved 1999-2004 General Obligation Street Improvement Bonds funded Capital Improvement Projects.

FISCAL IMPACT

No funds are to be expended in this ordinance.

COORDINATION

This ordinance was coordinated with the Finance Department, the Office of Management and Budget, the City Attorney's Office, and CPS.
