SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This ordinance authorizes the City Manager to accept \$21,782.00 and \$52,857.00 in carry over funding from the Health Resources & Services Administration (HRSA) to augment the ongoing Healthy Start Initiative in the San Antonio Metropolitan Health District (SAMHD) for the period ending May 31, 2004. This ordinance will also amend the project budget and revise the personnel complement.

Staff recommends approval.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The San Antonio Healthy Start Initiative brings together community leaders to identify and address disparities associated with maternal and infant health. In addition, the project works to increase public awareness regarding the root causes and prevention of infant mortality through community health education. It also provides extensive outreach, case management and health education interventions to at-risk women and families within a specific target community in San Antonio. In order to promote longer interconceptional periods and prevent relapses of risk-taking behaviors, project services are planned for mother and infant through the infant's second year of life.

In 2001 SAMHD successfully obtained a four-year grant from HRSA to operate the Healthy Start Initiative with an annual budget of \$750,000.00 per year. During the first two years of the grant, some of the funds were not expended. This occurred mostly in Year 1 when the program was being set up and staffed. Fortunately, these funds are still available to the program and HRSA is now offering two separate grant awards, \$21,782.00 and \$52,857.00, a total of \$74,639.00.

Since Healthy Start has experienced an increase in the number of clients being served, these funds will be utilized to add a staff position (Public Health Aide) and to augment the outreach and case management activities. However, the total personnel complement of fourteen (14) positions will not change due to the elimination of a vacant and unnecessary Building Custodian position.

POLICY ANALYSIS

Passage of this ordinance will continue the long-standing practice of utilizing Federal and State aid to support the local public health programs of the City.

FISCAL IMPACT

This anticipated carry over funding from HRSA will provide \$74,639.00 in support to augment the Healthy Start Initiative project in the SAMHD. Any funding not expended this year will be eligible to be carried over in future years. Acceptance of this funding will place no demand on the City General Fund.

COORDINATION

The City Attorney's Office and the Department of Human Resources, Risk Management Division have reviewed and approved the HRSA Notice of Grant Award. The Finance Department has approved the proposed project budget.

SUPPLEMENTARY COMMENTS
