SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS:

COORDINATION:

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

All insurance requirements, public safety devices (signs, barricades) and any off-duty police as may be required by the Police Department or the Public Works Department shall be the responsibility of the event sponsor, Palm Heights Neighborhood Association. The City will receive revenues of \$25.00 from this event and will incur no additional costs.
