SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This Ordinance will grant a license agreement to San Antonio Independent School District to use, and maintain an existing footbridge over a drainage easement Public Right of Way at the Longfellow Middle School campus at 1130 East Sunshine Drive, in NCB 8398, in Council District No. 7, for a ten (10) year term and the consideration of \$5,000.00.

Staff recommends approval of this Ordinance.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Petitioner is requesting a License to use Public Right of Way over a drainage easement within NCB 8398 for an existing footbridge as shown on attached Exhibit "A." The San Antonio Independent School District (SAISD) purchased property northeast of the drainage easement for a parking lot and constructed a footbridge over the easement to provide pedestrian access from the parking lot to the Longfellow Middle School campus.

POLICY ANALYSIS

This action is consistent with the City Code and Ordinances which require City Council approval for any private use of property owned or controlled by the City.

FISCAL IMPACT

The City will collect \$5000.00 for this license to use Public Right of Way.

COORDINATION

In compliance with City procedures, this request has been canvassed through interested City departments, public utilities and applicable agencies. A Canvassing Checklist and an executed Letter of Agreement, by which the petitioner agrees with all conditions imposed through this canvassing, are attached for review.

SUPPLEMENTARY COMMENTS

The City of San Antonio's Planning Commission recommended approval of this request at its regular meeting of 5/26/2004.

The petitioner is exempt from filing a Discretionary Contracts Disclosure Statement.





PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT

CITY PUBLIC SERVICE BOARD

Approved provided any existing easements be retained. Any facilities that require removal/relocation are at petitioner's expense.

The fee established for this license agreement is \$5,000.00 for a 10-year term. This license fee is due and payable to the City of San Antonio prior to City Council consideration. If for some reason the license is not approved by City Council, the fee will be returned to the petitioner. Also, a Certificate of Insurance must be provided and the City of San Antonio must be formally released from any and all liabilities, which may be incurred in connection with this request.

If you concur with the above mentioned conditions, including the payment of the fee established for this license, please countersign this letter in the space provided below and return to the undersigned. Upon receipt of this signed Letter of Agreement, the License Agreement, the Certificate of Insurance and the fee we will continue processing of your request.
