SUBJECT: Designating honorary signage on Sunbelt Drive from the 3500 to 6900
blocks for George "Iceman" Gervin

SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This ordinance requests that the 3500 to 6900 blocks of Sunbelt Drive have the honorary name of George "Iceman" Gervin. The request is for honorary signage and will not involve changing the street name.

Staff recommends approval.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

A Council Consideration Request (CCR) to designate the 3500 to 6900 blocks of Sunbelt Drive with the honorary name George "Iceman" Gervin was submitted by Councilman Joel Williams (please see attached). The designation will recognize and honor the accomplishments of Mr. Gervin.

The Governance Committee reviewed the CCR at their meeting on May 5, 2004 and directed this item to the Quality of Life Committee. During their June 3, 2004 meeting, the Quality of Life Committee directed that this item be placed on the Council agenda.

Approximately six (6) signs will be installed with a sign posted at intersecting streets within the limits. Sign installation will take approximately 10 days to be completed by City staff.

POLICY ANALYSIS

This ordinance is in accordance with past action by City Council to honor an individual while retaining the official street name.

FINANCIAL IMPACT

The cost of installing signs along Sunbelt Drive with the honorary name George "Iceman" Gervin is \$155. Funds are available from the District 2 Neighborhood Access and Mobility Fund.

COORDINATION


This request for Ordinance has been coordinated with the City Attorney's Office, Development Services Department, Finance, and Office of Management and Budget.
