Staff Recommendation:

Approval. The requested zoning is consistent with the South Central San Antonio Community Plan's recommendation for office, light commercial, and medium-high density residential land use. The subject property has been used as parking for the Gonzaba Medical Group since 1987 which is located immediately across Pleasanton Road. The applicant is requesting a zoning change for the extension of the existing parking and future development of medical offices and physical therapy. The South Central San Antonio Community Plan recognizes the Gonzaba Medical Group as an asset for the community. The Plan also calls for the attraction of additional medical clinics and enhancement of existing clinics to provide health services. Considering the close proximity of the adjacent residences, the following conditions are recommended:

- 1. A fifteen (15) foot buffer with Type B plant materials shall be constructed and maintained along the property line of adjoining residentially zoned lots.
- 2. A six (6) foot solid screen fence shall be constructed and maintained along the property line of adjoining residentially zoned lots.
- 3. Exterior lighting fixtures shall not emit a significant amount of fixture total output above a vertical cut-off angle of ninety degrees.
