SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

The purpose of this ordinance is to authorize the City Manager, or her designated representative, to accept an \$186,912 grant from the Texas Engineering Extension Service for the State Homeland Security Law Enforcement Terrorism Prevention Program.

Staff recommends approval.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Funds for this grant are provided by the United States Department of Homeland Security, Office of Domestic Preparedness awarded to the State of Texas. The grant award of \$186,912 may be utilized for equipment, planning, training and exercises. The proposed budget will assist in the replacement of existing outdated equipment and the adding of new equipment primarily for the Special Operations and the Crisis Negotiations Units. This will include updated tactical body armor, night vision devices, portable thermal imager, boom microphone and headphone, updated computer software and hardware for interagency communication and a radio interconnect device. This device will be installed in the command trailer and will allow patching of various portable radio units such as DPS, FBI, and local law enforcement agencies or outside agency responders so that each radio can communicate regardless of brand or frequency.

POLICY ANALYSIS

This Ordinance continues City Council's policy of seeking intergovernmental financial assistance for City crime prevention and enforcement programs.

FISCAL IMPACT

The grant provideds for reimbursement of eligible expenditures. No City match is required.

COORDINATION

This ordinance request has been coordinated with Finance, City Attorney's Office, City Manager's Office and the Office of Management & Budget.
