The subject property is currently vacant with commercial uses and zoning to the north, west, and south. The proposed C-2 is a more appropriate zoning for the subject property given the existing commercial uses and zoning in the area. The applicant is proposing to develop a medical office building that will provide health services and be an asset to the community.

Applicant: Kathleen G. Halka, MD

Zoning Request: "I-1" General Industrial District to "C-2" General Commercial District.

Commissioner Stribling recused myself from this case.

Andy Guerrero, 3134 Renker, representing the applicant, stated their intent is to develop a single story medical office building on the subject property. He further stated they would provide landscaping along Lexington and Euclid. He stated this request is consistent with the surrounding uses. He stated he has contacted both neighborhood associations to present his proposal.

OPPOSE

John Thompson, representing the Tobin Hill Residents Association, stated they feel this request is inappropriate for this area. He stated they have not been in contact with the applicant or representative and would like to further discuss this proposal. He stated they would like some revisions made before this case is presented to City Council.

Staff stated there were 28 notices mailed out to the surrounding property owners, 0 returned in opposition and 5 returned in favor and Tobin Hill Neighborhood Association is in favor. There was no response from Tobin Hill Residents Association.

Everyone present, for and against having been heard and the results of the written notices having been received, the Chairman declared the public hearing closed.

COMMISSION ACTION

The motion was made by Commissioner Kissling and seconded by Commissioner McAden to recommend approval.
