SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATION

This ordinance acknowledges contract modifications to the Alamo Child Care Delivery System (CCDS) contract with Alamo Workforce Development, Inc. (AWD) for the period of September 1, 2003 through August 31, 2004 and authorizes the acceptance of additional CCDS funds in the amount of \$2,293,402 for the provision of childcare, quality initiatives and related services. Further, this ordinance authorizes the acceptance of CCDS funding in an amount up to \$3,300,000 to extend the current AWD contract one month to September 30, 2004 to realign the fiscal year and, accordingly, authorizes a contract amendment with the Alamo Area Development Corporation (AADC), to extend their sub-contract period one month to September 30, 2004 and provide additional funding in the amount of \$58,496. This ordinance also adopts a revised CCDS program budget and personnel complement.

Staff recommends approval of this ordinance.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Texas Workforce Commission (TWC) is responsible for administering the State's childcare program and contracts the responsibility for the integrated delivery of childcare and workforce programs to local workforce development boards throughout the state. AWD, the local workforce board that serves Bexar and the 11 surrounding counties, has contracted the City's Department of Community Initiatives' (DCI) Child Care Delivery System Division (CCDSD) to operate the Alamo CCDS program and provide overall coordination, client services, fiscal management, and vendor management. CCDSD also provides participants with eligibility and certification services, counseling on the selection of childcare, and referrals to all participating childcare facilities.

TWC administers the Workforce Investment Act (WIA) program that serves as a resource to dislocated workers and other individuals in support of workforce preparation and other employment readiness services. Upon determining WIA eligibility, workforce centers refer clients to CCDS for childcare services while they are enrolled and participating in a WIA program. In order to ensure continuity of care, AWD is reallocating funds in the amount of \$20,000 to support WIA childcare referrals from the workforce centers. It is estimated that up to 5 additional low-income children will receive care through these WIA supportive funds.

AWD has reviewed their current year Child Care Development Fund (CCDF) appropriation to identify funds available for release prior to their expiration. Reallocated funds will support childcare services, quality initiatives and operations in connection with the Alamo CCDS program. Specifically, \$322,360 will support direct childcare services and operations. It is estimated that 21 additional low-income children will receive care through these reallocated CCDF funds. The remaining balance of \$157,640 is earmarked toward the Single Portal of Entry childcare repository that will improve the efficiency of childcare access in the community.

Historically, the Texas Department of Family and Protective Services (TDFPS) provides sufficient childcare funding to support referrals from Child Protective Services (CPS). This year, TDFPS proposes to provide an estimated \$1,793,402 to sustain care for all children referred from CPS to the CCDS program. It is anticipated that this amount will maintain the current level of service to 477 children provided through referrals from CPS.

Concerning the additional one month of CCDS funding, the TWC endeavors to realign its fiscal year to mirror the federal fiscal year that begins on October 1 and concludes on September 30. In order to adjust the fiscal year, AWD is allocating one additional month of funding in an amount up to \$3,300,000 to align CCDS programs to the federal fiscal year. One month funding appropriation will support both program operations and direct child care services. In response to the change of the fiscal year, the City is amending the delegate agency contract with AADC to include the month of September and provide additional funding in the amount of \$58,496. AADC is the sole sub-grantee with the City of San Antonio to provide CCDS services to families and children in the 11 surrounding counties within the Alamo Workforce Development Area.

In order to accommodate the changing mix of childcare services required, the personnel complement has been reduced by 15 positions by eliminating 17 unfilled grant positions that are no longer needed and adding two grant positions that have become necessary for program operations.

POLICY ANALYSIS

Pursuant to Ordinance No. 98090, passed and approved on August 28, 2003, City Council authorized the operation of the Alamo CCDS program from September 1, 2003 to August 31, 2005. This contract modification continues existing City policies to administer the CCDS program through funding from AWD and TWC. This action also reflects a continuation of existing policies supporting the City's investment priorities including Family Strengthening and Workforce Development.

The Texas Legislative Budget Board sets accountability measures for programs administered through TWC and the Local Workforce Development Boards. The following performance standards are assigned the Alamo CCDS program for FY 2003-2004:

FISCAL IMPACT

This ordinance authorizes the acceptance of additional CCDS funds in the amount of \$2,293,402 from AWD for the provision of childcare and related services for the 2003-2004 CCDS program. This amount is comprised of \$20,000 in WIA funds, \$480,000 in CCDF funds, and an estimated \$1,793,402 in TDFPS funding. Further, this ordinance also authorizes the acceptance of one-month CCDS funding up to the amount of \$3,300,000 for the period of September 1, 2004 – September 30, 2004. This ordinance amends the delegate agency contract with AADC to extend the contract period to September 30, 2004 and provide funding in the amount of \$58,496. Additionally, this action approves budget revision No. 7 to the CCDS 2003-2004 program year budget. There is no additional General Fund commitment. Attachment A reflects a summary of budget revisions for this contract period.

COORDINATION

DCI coordinated activities with the Alamo Workforce Development, Inc., City Attorney's Office, and the Finance Department.

SUPPLEMENTARY COMMENTS

CCDSD anticipates accepting second year funding of a two-year grant under the Child Care Delivery System Program for FY 2005 – FY 2006 at a later date.

Provisions of the Ethics Ordinance do not apply.
