CITY COUNCIL WORKSESSONS ON THE FY 2005 PROPOSED BUDGET

During the Tuesday, August 24, 2004 City Council Worksession on the FY 2005 Proposed Budget, staff presented material covering efficiency proposals included within the City Manager's Proposed Budget and updates on efficiency initiatives. Additionally, the presentation covered economic development and neighborhood related proposed service delivery plans for FY 2005 and associated recommended program changes included within the FY 2005 Proposed Budget.
