#### **SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS:**

This ordinance will approve the parade permit and authorize the temporary closure of certain streets in connection with the 29<sup>th</sup> Annual Cultural Arts Parade being held on Saturday, September 25, 2004. The run/walk will assemble at San Jose, Napier, and Padre Dr. and disband at 4002 Roosevelt (Memorial Stadium). The route is attached.

Staff recommends approval of this ordinance.

### **POLICY ANALYSIS:**

This ordinance is consistent with the City policy requiring an ordinance where closures of public streets are requested.

#### **COORDINATION:**

This event has been coordinated with the City Manager's Office, the Traffic Section of the Police Department, and the Traffic Division of the Public Works Department. All of the involved city departments concur with the staff recommendation to approve this request.

#### FINANCIAL IMPACT:

All insurance requirements, public safety devices (signs, barricades) and any off-duty police as may be required by the Police Department or the Public Works Department shall be the responsibility of the event sponsor, Harlandale I.S.D. The City will receive revenues of \$25.00 from this event and will incur no additional costs.
