Zoning Request: "R-6" Residential Single Family District to PUD "R-6" Planned Unit

Development Residential Single Family District.

Ken Brown, 112 E. Pecan, representing the owner, stated they are requesting this change in zoning to develop a gated community on the subject property. He stated they are proposing to develop 140 single-family residential lots.

Staff stated there were 27 notices mailed out to the surrounding property owners, 2 returned in opposition and 2 returned in favor.

Everyone present, for and against having been heard and the results of the written notices having been received, the Chairman declared the public hearing closed.
