Parks and Recreation Facilities FY 2004/2005 - Otto Koehler Fund

SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This ordinance amends the City Code by increasing fees for use of public Parks and Recreation facilities in Brackenridge Park for which revenue is deposited into the Otto Koehler Fund. The fee adjustments will result in increased revenue in FY04/05 of \$12,900.00 to the Otto Koehler Fund.

Staff recommends approval.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

This ordinance amends the City Code to revise and increase user fees and permit charges for certain facilities administered by the Department of Parks and Recreation in Brackenridge Park. Specifically, the ordinance will

- increase Cypress Pavilion Permit Fees from \$25.00 to \$40.00 on Monday thru Thursday before 5:00 p.m. and from \$65.00 to \$80.00 on Friday thru Sunday, Holidays and after 5:00 p.m. Monday thru Thursday.
- increase Koehler Pavilion Permit Fees from \$25.00 to \$60.00 on Monday thru Thursday before 5:00 p.m. and from \$80.00 to \$100.00 on Friday thru Sunday, Holidays and after 5:00 p.m. Monday thru Thursday;

POLICY ANALYSIS

This ordinance is consistent with City policy in establishing permit and usage fees for City property and facilities.

FISCAL IMPACT

These fee changes will result in increased revenue of approximately \$12,900.00 to the Otto Koehler Fund.

COORDINATION

This action has been coordinated with the Office of Management and Budget.
