SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This Ordinance appropriates funds in the amount of \$297,653.00 from General Obligations of the City for facility improvements at the Municipal Plaza Building located at 114 W. Commerce and the Public Safety and Technology Center located at 515 Frio Street.

Staff recommends approval of this Ordinance.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

This project will provide continued funding for improvements to the Municipal Plaza Building, located at 114 W. Commerce Street, which would generally include moving expenses, painting, carpeting, minor remodeling and environmental remediation to vacant office space created by the completion of the Development and Business Services Center and subsequent personnel relocation. The project will also provide funding for improvements to the Public Safety and Technology Building, located at 515 Frio Street, to include engineering consulting, plumbing repairs, remediation of foundation subsidence and minor corrective remodeling. Both projects are to be completed in coordination with contractors and city staff from the Facility Services Division of Asset Management.

POLICY ANALYSIS

This action will provide for the continued maintenance of critical City facilities.

FISCAL IMPACT

Funds in the amount of \$177,136.00 from 1999 General Obligation Public Safety Improvements Bonds (45-933) and the amount of \$120,517.00 in 1994 Prior Issued Certificates of Obligation (43-401) for a total amount of \$297,653.00 are available.

COORDINATION

This request was coordinated with the Departments of Public Works, Finance, Police and Information Services.
