SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This Ordinance will renew a license (previous Ordinance 89573 expired April 17, 2004) with Houston Street Hotel Partners, L.P., a Delaware limited partnership, for the continued use of Public Rights of Way along East Houston, North St. Mary's and East Travis Streets, and a 14-foot wide alley (surface, subsurface and air rights) for an existing basement, balcony, an overhead parking structure, and a smokestack at the abutting Sheraton Gunter Hotel located at 205 East Houston Street, in NCB 407, in Council District No. 1, for a ten (10) year term and the consideration of \$402,520.00.

Staff recommends approval of this Ordinance.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Petitioner is requesting a license renewal for the continued use of Public Rights of Way along East Houston, North St. Mary's and East Travis Streets, and a 14-foot wide alley (surface, subsurface and air rights) for an existing basement, a balcony, an overhead parking structure and a smokestack at the Sheraton Gunter Hotel as shown on attached Exhibit "A", pages 1 through 9. More specifically, the Public Rights of Way are used for an existing 4,487 square-foot basement under and a 4,487 square-foot balcony over North St. Mary's and East Houston Streets; a 4-foot wide overhead encroachment by an existing parking structure of 1,304 square feet above East Travis and North St. Mary's Streets, and an existing smokestack and related 87 square-foot basement over and under a 14-foot wide alley adjacent to the east side of the hotel. Previous license was approved by Ordinance No. 89573, and expired on April 17, 2004.

POLICY ANALYSIS

This action is consistent with the City Code and Ordinances which require City Council approval for any private use of property owned or controlled by the City.

FISCAL IMPACT

The City will collect \$402,520.00 for this license to use Public Rights of Way, payable annually with the first payment of \$40,252.00, and each subsequent payment of \$40,252.00 due before the anniversary date of said Effective Date each year commencing in 2005.

COORDINATION

In compliance with City procedures, this request has been canvassed through interested City departments, public utilities and applicable agencies. A Canvassing Checklist and an executed Letter of Agreement, by which the petitioner agrees with all conditions imposed through this canvassing, are attached.





(1) Existing basement, balcony and smokestack encroachments in two tracts:

PART I

BEING 0.103 acres of land out of the street rights-of-way of East Houston Street and North St. Mary's Street adjacent to Lots 1, 2, 3 and 5, New City Block 407, within the City Limits of San Antonio, Bexar County, Texas, and being more particularly described as follows:

ORIGINATING: At an X found in the concrete walk at the point of intersection of the east right-of-way line of N. St. Mary¹s St. and the south right-of-way line of Travis Street, said corner being the northwest corner of Lot 2, New City Block 407;

S 00° 07° 13" W, 125.35 feet along the east right-of-way line of N. St. Mary's Street to an X inscribed in the concrete walk for the POINT OF BEGINNING of the hercinafter described tract;

THENCE: S 00° 07' 13" W, 205.09 feet along the east right-of-way line of N. St. Mary's Street and the western boundary of Lots 1 and 2, New City Block 407, to an X found in the concrete sidewalk at the corner of the intersection of the north right-of-way line of Houston Street and the east right-of-way line of N. St. Mary's Street for an interior corner of this tract;

THENCE: N 89° 58' 00" E, 155.32 feet along the north right-of-way line of Houston Street and the southern boundary of Lots 1, 3 and 5, New City Block 407, to a point in the north right-of-way line of Houston Street from whence an X was found in the concrete sidewalk bearing S 00° 07' 13" W a distance of 3.00 feet, said corner being the easternmost northeast corner of this tract;

THENCE: S 00° 02' 00" W, 17:30 feet to a point on the face of the curb of the north curb line of East Houston Street for the southeast corner of this tract;

THENCE: N 89° 55' 22" W, 150.28 feet along the north curb line of East Houston Street to a point of curvature of the curb line to the right;

THENCE: 20.81 feet along the arc of a curve to the right whose radius is 13.25 feet, delta angle is 89° 58' 25", tangent is 13.29 feet, and a chord of 18.73 feet which bears N 44° 56' 09" W to a point on the east curb line of N. St. Mary's Street for the southwest corner of this tract:

THENCE: N 00° 03' 03" E, 208.86 feet along the east curb line of N. St. Mary's Street to a point for the northwest corner of this tract;

TABNCE: S 890 52' 47" E, 8.45 feet to a point on the east right-of-way line of N. St. Mary's Street, said point being the POINT OF BEGINNING and containing 0.103 acres of land,

PART II

BEING 0.002 acres of land out of the variable width public alley running through New City Block 407 adjacent to the remaining portions of Lots 5 and 6, New City Block 407, within the City Limits of San Antonio, Bexar County, Texas, and being more particularly described as follows:

ORIGINATING: At an X found in the concrete walk at the point of intersection of the east right-of-way line of N. St. Mary's Street and the south right-of-way line of Travis Street, said point being the northwest corner of Lot 2, New City Block 407;

S 89° 48' 40" E, 155.32 feet along the south right-of-way line of Travis Street and the north boundary line of Lots 2, 4 and 6, New City Block 407 to an X found in the concrete at the point of intersection of the south right-of-way line of Travis Street and the west right-of-way line of a public alley;

S 00° 07° 13" W, 129.70 feet along the west right-of-way line of a public alley and the east boundary line of the Gunter Hotel property, following the east edge of the exterior wall of the Gunter Hotel;

S 89° 52° 47° E, 3.80 feet along the west right-of-way line of the public alley and the east edge of the Gunter Botel;

S 00° 07° 13" W, 29.00 feet along the west right—of—way line of the public alley and the east edge of the Gunter Hotel to the POINT OF BEGINNING of the hereinafter described tract;


THENCE: S 89° 52' 47° E, 3.20 feet to a point in the variable width public alley for the northeast corner of this tract;


BALCONY & BASEMENT ENCROACHMENT SECTION SCALE: 1'-6'

With reference to the captioned project, please be advised that the City of San Antonio has now completed the canvassing process and will recommend approval of a license to use Public Rights of Way subject to the following conditions:

PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT

Storm Water Engineering Division: Approved provided it is ensured that there is positive drainage in alley. At times, there appears to be standing water at Travis and the alley.

Also, the fee established for this license agreement is \$402,520.00 for a ten (10)-year term, payable annually with the first payment of \$40,252.00 due and payable to the City of San Antonio prior to City Council consideration. If for some reason the license is not approved by City Council, the fee will be returned to the petitioner. Also, a Certificate of Insurance must be provided and the City of San Antonio must be formally released from any and all liabilities, which may be incurred in connection with this request.

Further, a fully completed and signed Discretionary Contracts Disclosure Statement is required. A form is enclosed for your convenience.

If you concur with the above mentioned conditions, including the payment of the fee established for this license, please countersign this letter in the space provided below and return to the undersigned. Upon receipt of this signed Letter of Agreement, the License Agreement, the Certificate of Insurance, the Discretionary Contracts Disclosure Statement and the payment we will continue processing your request.

This Letter of Agreement is being offered by the City of San Antonio only to the above named petitioner and will expire thirty (30) days after the date of issuance unless a specific extension is requested by the petitioner and granted by the City.
