SUBJECT: Veteran's Day Parade Allocations

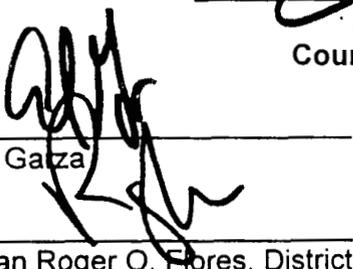
DATE: November 3, 2004

Your favorable consideration of this matter is appreciated.



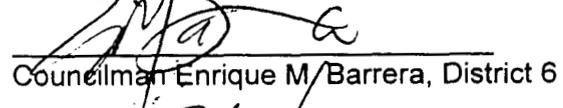

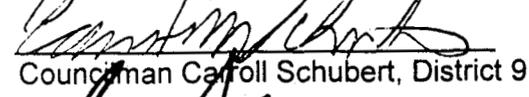

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SUBJECT: Veteran's Day Parade Allocations

DATE: November 5, 2004

I respectfully request Council concurrence to place on the November 18, 2004 Council agenda an allocation of \$7,000 to be paid from the FY 1999 District 7 One Time Project Funds.

The funds will be taken from the Housing Rehabilitation Model Block Program. A large portion of the money, \$6,591.00 will be transferred directly to SAPD Traffic Division to offset the cost of security. There will be \$86.00 transferred directly to the Parks & Recreation Department to offset the rental cost of two golf carts. The balance of \$323.00 will be used to reimburse the United States Military Veterans Parade Association for a portion of barricade expenses associated with the Parade.
