SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATION

This ordinance will authorize the execution of an amendment to the professional services contract with Bracewell & Patterson, L.L.P. to allow for payment in the amount of amount of \$115,261.00 for additional legal services provided in negotiating the Lease and Development Agreement for the development, operation and maintenance of the Tower of the Americas. This ordinance will also authorize appropriation of \$115,261 from 2003-2007 Park Bond Funds for these legal services.

Staff recommends approval of this ordinance.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

On March 4, 2004, the City Council passed Ordinance No. 98910, selecting Landry's Restaurants, Inc. (Landry's) and authorizing contract negotiations for the development, operation and maintenance of the Tower of the Americas. Because of the complexity and uniqueness of the issues involved in this transaction, the City Attorney sought outside legal expertise to provide all necessary legal services. The law firm of Bracewell & Patterson was selected and performed legal services on behalf of the City including preparing and negotiating a Lease and Development Agreement with Landry's which was passed and approved by City Council on November 18, 2004 by Ordinance 99996. Negotiations proved more difficult and longer than originally anticipated causing the legal fees to exceed the original estimate.

The Bracewell & Patterson attorneys involved in this transaction are located in Houston, Texas. This firm was selected by the City Attorney based on their expertise in the areas of contract law and contract negotiation. Thomas O. Moore, III, a partner in the firm, has been designated as the lead attorney for this engagement. Ron I. Erlichman, an associate attorney with Bracewell & Patterson, is assisting in this transaction. This law firm provides significant collective experience in the areas of law applicable to this transaction.

POLICY ANALYSIS

The contract with Bracewell & Patterson L.L.P. was approved through Ordinance 99387 on June 24, 2004. The firm has entered into a professional services contract with the City which requires compliance with the City Attorney's Office Guidelines.

FISCAL IMPACT

The sum of \$125,000 has previously been appropriated. This ordinance will appropriate an additional \$115,261 from 2003-2007 Park Bond Funds proceeds for these professional services. This is the final amount needed for this project.

COORDINATION

This Council action has been coordinated through the City Manager's Office and the Parks and Recreation Department.
