### **SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS**

This ordinance is to change the street name of Cassava Place to Grace Place as submitted by John and Katherine Soliz.

Staff recommends approval.

## **BACKGROUND INFORMATION**

Mr. & Mrs. Soliz requested that the street Cassava Place, located in Council District 9, be changed to Grace Place to honor a family member. Cassava Place is a one-block street, which has no residents and feeds into property owned by Mr. & Mrs. Soliz.

As per the requirements of Chapter 2, Article VI of the City Code of San Antonio, a committee was established to hold a public hearing to consider this request. The committee consisted of Razi Hosseini, representing the Director of Public Works; Kathy Soliz, the Community Representative; and Florencio Peña, Director of Development Services. As required under the City Code, notice of the public hearing was advertised through public service announcements, through media releases and by mail to all residents, businesses, and owners of the properties to be named.

The U.S. Postal Service, pursuant to Unified Development Code requirements, approved the new street name.

The public hearing was held on December 13, 2004, at 6:00 PM at the Development and Business Services Center. At the conclusion of the hearing, the committee quorum voted to recommend to the City Council that Cassava Place be changed to Grace Place.

### **POLICY ANALYSIS**

The naming and renaming of city streets is regulated under Chapter 2, Article VI of the City Code. This action is consistent with these regulations.

# **FISCAL IMPACT**

Mr. & Mrs. Soliz paid the administrative cost of \$303.27 to process this request and for the replacement of signs.
