SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This ordinance acknowledges contract modifications with Alamo Workforce Development, Inc. (AWD) awarding funds in the amount of \$870,000 for direct childcare and operations within the Alamo Area Child Care Delivery System (CCDS) Program for the period beginning October 1, 2004 through December 31, 2004. Additionally, it authorizes execution of an amendment to the delegate agency contract with Alamo Area Development Corporation (AADC) providing additional funds in the amount of \$70,000 for the period of October 1, 2004 through September 30, 2005; adopts a revised FY 2004-2005 CCDS program budget and approves a revised personnel complement.

Staff recommends the approval of this ordinance.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Texas Workforce Commission (TWC) is responsible for administering the State's childcare program and contracts the responsibility for the integrated delivery of childcare and workforce programs to local workforce development boards throughout the state. Alamo Workforce Development, Inc., the local workforce board serving Bexar and 11 surrounding counties, contracts with the City's Department of Community Initiatives' (DCI) Child Care Delivery System Division (CCDSD) to operate the Alamo Area CCDS which provides overall coordination, client services, fiscal management, provider services and quality improvement activities.

AADC provides CCDS services to families and children in the 11 counties surrounding Bexar County within the Alamo Workforce Development Area. Services available to the rural counties through AADC include client services, provider services, and quality improvement.

AWD has identified additional Child Care Development Funds in the amount of \$870,000 and desires to modify the CCDS contract by awarding such funds to the City for the provision of direct childcare and operations. Accordingly, the City proposes to amend its delegate agency contract with AADC to provide additional funds in the amount of \$70,000 in connection with the Childcare Delivery System's rural counties.

POLICY ANALYSIS

This ordinance addresses the core issues of Human Development and Family Strengthening and continues existing City policy of providing high quality early childhood education to enhance workforce development efforts. The additional funding will enable CCDS to serve approximately 250 additional children.

FISCAL IMPACT

This ordinance accepts additional grant funding from AWD for FY05 in the amount of \$870,000 for the provision of direct childcare and operations. Additionally, this ordinance provides additional funding for FY05 to AADC for rural childcare services in the amount of \$70,000. There will be no impact to the City's General Fund.

COORDINATION

DCI coordinated activities with AWD, the Finance Department, the City Attorney's Office, and the Office of Management and Budget and the Alamo Area Council of Governments.




