

The Rehabilitation Council of Texas (RCT) was federally mandated by the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, as amended in 1992. The RCT reviews, analyzes, and advises the Texas Rehabilitation Commission (TRC) on policy, scope, effectiveness of vocational rehabilitation (VR) services and eligibility, requirements, and works in partnership with the commission to develop, agree to, and review state goals and priorities. The RCT also contributes to the preparation of the State Plan for VR.

Council members are appointed by the Texas governor and serve three-year, staggered terms. With the exception of the Client Assistance Program representative, members cannot serve more than two consecutive terms. A majority of RCT members must be individuals with disabilities and not employed by TRC.

The RCT conducts two-day, quarterly meetings in Austin. To attend council meetings and perform council functions, members are reimbursed for reasonable and necessary expenses. Public comment is encouraged at all meetings.

#### MISSION STATEMENT

The Rehabilitation Council of Texas:

- Works in partnership with the Texas Rehabilitation Commission (TRC) on the development, prioritization, and review of the State Plan
- Works in partnership with TRC to evaluate the effectiveness of vocational rehabilitation services
- Analyzes the effectiveness of, and consumer satisfaction with, vocational rehabilitation services and outcomes
- Advises TRC concerning its performance with regard to eligibility, extent, scope, and effectiveness of services provided, and outcomes
- Coordinates with the State independent Living Council, the Texas Education Agency, and the Texas Council on Workforce and Economic Competitiveness and other organizations to avoid duplication of efforts and enhance the number of individuals served
- Serves as a mechanism for bringing consumer concerns and advice to the TRC

#### **GUIDING PRINCIPLES**

THE RCT BELIEVES THAT ALL PEOPLE RECEIVING VOCATIONAL REHABILITATION SERVICES HAVE THE RIGHT TO:

- · Be treated with worth and dignity
- Be fully informed of their rights and responsibilities in the rehabilitation process
- Receive vocational rehabilitation services which result in work goals that allow them to live independently and
  participate in their communities to the extent they desire
- Be partners in planning and implementing their services to the extent they desire
- And be informed of the full range of services that will assist them in achieving their rehabilitation goals.
