SUBJECT: Designating honorary signage on Mystic Park as the Ernani Falcone Memorial Way

DATE: February 3, 2005

SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This ordinance bestows the designation of "Ernani Falcone Memorial Way" upon the 7500 – 8700 Blocks of Mystic Park Street. The request is for honorary signage and will not involve changing the street name.

Staff recommends approval of this ordinance.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

A Council Consideration Request (CCR) to designate Mystic Park as the Ernani Falcone Memorial Way was submitted by Mayor Edward D. Garza and Councilman Julián Castro (please see attached). The designation will recognize and honor the accomplishments of Mr. Ernani Falcone.

The Governance Committee reviewed the CCR at their meeting on January 19, 2005 and directed that this item be placed on the Council agenda.

Approximately five (5) signs will be installed, one (1) ground mount assembly and four (4) overhead signs. Sign installation will take approximately 10 days to complete.

POLICY ANALYSIS

This ordinance is in accordance with past action by City Council to honor an individual while retaining the official street name.

COORDINATION






