SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS:

This ordinance will approve the parade permit and authorize the temporary closure of certain streets in connection with the Cesar Chavez March for Justice Parade being held on Saturday, March 26, 2005. The run/walk will assemble at Avenida Guadalupe Parking Lot and disband at Alamo Plaza. The route is attached.

Staff recommends approval of this ordinance.

POLICY ANALYSIS:

This ordinance is consistent with the City policy requiring an ordinance where closures of public streets are requested.

COORDINATION:



FINANCIAL IMPACT:


