SUBJECT: Veteran's Day Parade Allocations



I respectfully request Council concurrence to place on the March 3, 2005 Council agenda an ordinance which would amend Ordinance No. 100137 passed on December 9, 2004 in order to adjust the approved allocation of FY 1999 District 7 One Time Project Funds from an estimated \$6,591.00 in SAPD security costs to the actual cost of \$5,045.89 incurred by the United States Military Veterans Parade Association in connection with the annual Veterans Day Parade held on November 6, 2004. The difference of \$1,868.11 would be used by the Association to supplement the previously approved amount of \$323.00 for barricade expenses associated with the Parade.
