SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS

This ordinance accepts the low, qualified bid by Greco Construction, Inc., a SBE/WBE firm, to perform construction work in connection with the Rosedale Park Improvements Project in City Council District 5 for the base bid amount of \$154,900.00, and with bid alternate 1 of \$3,800.00 and bid alternate 2 of \$5,700.00 for a total contract amount of \$164,400.00; authorizes the execution of a standard construction contract; allocates \$11,902.17 for construction contingency, \$4,000.00 for civil engineering Storm Water Management Plan fees, and \$700.00 for mandatory project fees, for a total amount of \$181,002.17; authorizes appropriations of \$54,846.17 from 1994-1999 Park Bond Funds, \$100,000.00 from 1999-2004 Park Bond Funds, and \$26,156.00 from revenues collected for UDC fees in lieu of park land dedication; and provides for payment.

Staff recommends approval of this ordinance.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Funding was approved in the 1994 and 1999 Park Bond Issues for improvements to Rosedale Park, located at 303 Dartmouth in City Council District 5. The community and the United Rosedale Organization provided much input on the improvements to the park and were very involved in the determination of the final scope of work. Repairs to flooring and replacement of bleachers in the Westside YMCA have already been approved and are underway. This portion of the project will consist of ADA modifications to the restroom building near the baseball fields and development of a new parking lot that will also serve that area of the park. Also, landscape irrigation and plant material will be installed to the entrance area off of General McMullen. The project has been designed in-house, with some consultant assistance for drainage and architectural details.

The construction bid was advertised on the last week of November and the first week of December 2004 in the <u>Commercial Recorder</u>, <u>San Antonio Informer</u>, and <u>La Prensa De San Antonio</u>. Seven qualified bids were received and Greco Construction, Inc., a SBE/WBE firm, was selected with the base bid of \$154,900.00 and with bid alternate 1 of \$3,800.00 and bid alternate 2 of \$5,700.00 for a total amount of \$164,400.00. A standard construction contract will be executed. A summary of the bids is shown on Exhibit 1. The firm has no current City projects.

It is anticipated that the construction work will begin in April 2005 and will be completed in September 2005.

POLICY ANALYSIS

This ordinance will provide for completion of the Rosedale Park improvements, as approved by the 1994 and 1999 Park Bond Issues. The construction contract was advertised and selected in accordance with established bid procedures.

FISCAL IMPACT

Funds of \$150,000.00 in 1994-1999 Park Bond Funds and \$100,000.00 in 1999-2004 Park Bond funds have been approved for improvements to Rosedale Park. Unified Development Code (UDC) fees of \$26,156.00 collected for this area will also be utilized. The amount of \$95,153.83 has previously been encumbered for design fees and for improvements to the Westside YMCA. This ordinance will appropriate \$164,400.00 for construction fees, \$11,902.17 for construction contingency fees, \$4,000.00 for civil engineering Storm Water Management Plan fees, and \$700.00 for mandatory project fees. The General Fund is not impacted.

COORDINATION

This action has been coordinated with the community, the United Rosedale Organization (URO), Public Works Department, Finance Department, and Office of Management and Budget.





Accompanying this Bid is a Bid Guaranty in the amount of <u>five Percent (5%)</u> percent of the greatest total amount of the Bid. Said Bid Guaranty, in the form of a Certified or Cashier's Check on a State of National Bank, or Bid Bond, is submitted as a guaranty of the good faith of the Bidder and that the Bidder will execute and enter into a written contract to do the work, if his bid is accepted. The Bidder by submitting this completed form hereby agrees that if he/she fails to execute the written contract and furnish satisfactory bond, within ten (10) calendar days after City Council award, the City of San Antonio shall, in any of such events, be entitled and is hereby given the right to retain said Bid Guaranty as liquidated damages. It is understood that the City of San Antonio reserves the right to reject any and all proposals whenever the City Council deems it in the interest of the City to do so, and also the right to waive any informalities in a bid.

In the event of the award of a contract to the undersigned, the undersigned will execute same on Construction Contract (General Form) and make bond for the full amount of the contract, to secure proper compliance with the terms and provisions of the contract, and to insure and guarantee the work until final completion and acceptance or the end of the guarantee period where so stipulated, and to guarantee payment of all lawful claims for labor performed and materials furnished in the fulfillment of the contract.

The work proposed to be done shall be accepted when fully completed and finished to the entire satisfaction of the Director of Public Works. The undersigned certifies all prices contained in this bid have been carefully checked and are submitted as correct and final.
