

**SUMMARY AND RECOMMENDATIONS:**

This ordinance will approve the parade permit and authorize the temporary closure of certain streets in connection with the Race for the Cure being held on Saturday, April 2, 2005. The run/walk will assemble at Cherry between Commerce and Kansas and disband at the C-lot of the Alamodome. The route is attached.

Staff recommends approval of this ordinance.

**POLICY ANALYSIS:**

This ordinance is consistent with the City policy requiring an ordinance where closures of public streets are requested.

**COORDINATION:**




